



CANADIAN INTERNATIONAL MERCHANDISE TRADE – JULY 2020

[Statistics Canada](#) reports exports and imports of goods in July continued to build on gains observed in June. Exports were up 11.1% in July and imports rose 12.7%.

Canada's merchandise trade deficit with the world increased from \$1.6 billion in June to \$2.5 billion in July.

Goods Exports (July 2020)

- Total goods exports in July amounted to \$45.4 billion, \$2.9 billion lower than the February level.
- Motor Vehicles and parts increased 37% to \$8.2 billion.
- Goods exports to the United States rose 15.1% to \$33.5 billion.
- Goods exports to countries other than the United States were up 1.1% to \$11.9 billion.
