



EMPLOYER HIRING INTENTIONS FOR Q4 2020 – MGC SURVEY

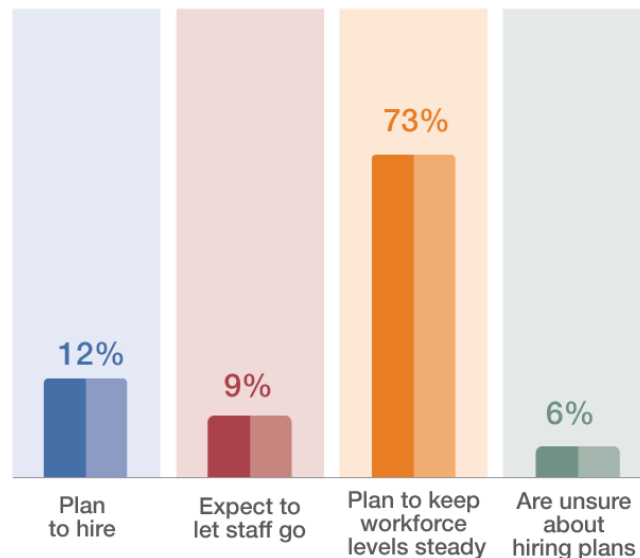
[ManpowerGroup Canada](#) has conducted a survey of more than 1,000 employers across Canada regarding their hiring intentions for the fourth quarter of 2020.

The MGC report states, “Canadian employers report cautious hiring plans for the upcoming quarter. With 12% of employers expecting to increase payrolls, 9% anticipating a decrease and 73% forecasting no change, the resulting Net Employment Outlook is +3%. Once the data is adjusted to allow for seasonal variation, the Outlook stands at +6%. Hiring sentiment improves by a considerable margin of 15 percentage points when compared with the previous quarter, but declines by 6 percentage points in comparison with last year at this time.”

Ontario has the highest hiring intentions in Q4. MGC notes, in Ontario “job seekers can expect a cautiously optimistic hiring climate in the next three months, according to employers who report a Net Employment Outlook of +10%.”
