Parade Horse Participant Rules and Regulations

I understand that in order to ride in the Barnesville Buggy Days Parade, I must abide by the following rules for the safety, wellbeing, and protection of myself, the horses, and the spectators. I understand that failure to abide by these rules may result in my being removed from the parade and the possibility of not being allowed to participate in future Buggy Days Parades and other events hosted by the Barnesville-Lamar County Chamber of Commerce.

1. All horse owners must provide, at the time of registration, proof of a current and negative Coggins test for every horse they are entering in the parade. Coggins reports cannot be older than one (1) year from the date of the parade (9/22/18). Horse markings will be checked to make sure Coggins reports match each individual horse.

2. The registration deadline is Friday, September 14, 2018. The deadline and requirements must be adhered to without exception. There is a \$5.00 registration fee per horse that must be paid with the application, however there is no charge if you are providing a buggy along with your horse(s). Late entry applications will be accepted until Wednesday, September 19, 2018 with a \$25.00 late fee per horse. No applications will be processed after the late entry date.

3. The following rules must be adhered to at all times for the safety and security of all participants and spectators:
- All groups should ride together.
 - No face coverings will be allowed. Bandanas are permitted as long as they do not cover the face of the participant.
 - All riders must maintain strict control of the horse at all times.
 - Absolutely no alcohol is permitted before or during the parade.
 - All foals must be accompanied by a lead line.
 - In accordance with Georgia State Law, and because we take the safety of all participants and spectators extremely seriously, absolutely no cellphone usage is permitted in the staging area or while operating a horse during the parade. No exceptions.

Riders and Horses are encouraged to be well-groomed and dressed accordingly. Riders should check all equipment in advance of the parade. Once you arrive to the parade staging area, Official Buggy Days Volunteers (orange shirts), will direct riders to watering and staging areas.
