# BARNESVILLE BUGGY DAYS PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED AND RETURNED TO THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE NO LATER THAN **WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2018**

1. **NO ARTICLES** (candy, gum, trinkets, etc.) are permitted to be thrown or tossed from a float, vehicle, or horse participating in the Buggy Days parade. This will be strictly enforced by the Barnesville Police Department. However, it is acceptable for participants associated with a float, vehicle, or horse to walk alongside and pass out items to the crowd.
2. All participants must remain in constant motion that maintains the pace ahead of them in the parade. At no time is it permissible for a float, vehicle, group, or horse to change pace, slow, or stop on their own volition.
3. No face coverings/masks will be permitted. Bandanas/head gear are allowed as part of the theme/decoration as long as they do not cover the face of the participant.
4. All marching bands must be appropriately uniformed and maintain the pace of the parade. Exceptions are only made for the reviewing and judging station in downtown Barnesville.
5. All single vehicles must be convertibles unless they are a classic/antique or custom. No pick-up trucks or SUVs are permitted unless they are being used as a towing vehicle. Drivers are to be at least 16 years of age with a valid, non-restrictive driver's license.
6. **Absolutely no texting or phone usage during the parade (Georgia State Law). This is to ensure the safety of all participants.**
7. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
8. All vehicles and float entries must be decorated and conform to the annual Buggy Day's theme as much as possible to be considered for prize entry. In addition, each vehicle must have a least one identifying sign of professional and readable quality from a distance. Antique and custom cars are can be exempt from this requirement.
