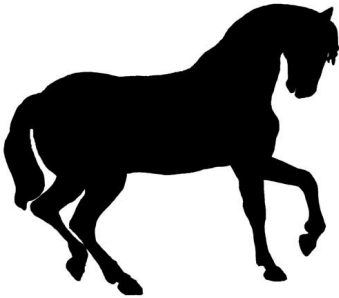

I understand that in order to ride in the Barnesville Buggy Days Parade, I must abide by the following rules for the safety and protection of my person, the horses, and the spectators. I understand that failure to abide by these rules may result in being removed from the parade and the possibility of not being allowed in future parades.

1. **All horse owners must provide, at the time of registration, proof of a current negative Coggins test for every horse in the parade. Coggins report cannot be older than one year from the date of the parade, September 21, 2018. Horse markings will be checked to make sure Coggins report matches the horse.**
2. **Registration Deadline is FRIDAY, September 13, 2019, This deadline and requirements must be adhered to without exception. Registration fee is \$5.00 per horse and must be paid with application. There is NO charge for the buggies. Applications will be accepted until Friday, September 13, 2019 with a late entry fee of \$25.00 per horse. NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER Friday, SEPTEMBER 13th, 2019**
3. Horse groups should ride together.

---There is no running, rearing, or otherwise reckless riding along the parade route.

---No face coverings will be allowed. Bandanas may be worn as long as they do not cover the face of parade participants.

---All riders will maintain control of the horse at all times.

---No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the staging area or during the parade.

---Any foals must be accompanied by a lead line.

---WE TAKE THE SAFETY OF ALL PARTICIPANTS EXTREMELY SERIOUSLY, THEREFORE

TEXTING IN THE STAGING AREA AND WHILE OPERATING A HORSE DURING THE PARADE IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

The City of Barnesville and the Barnesville-Lamar County Chamber of Commerce, including its members and Board of Directors, do not provide liability insurance for the protection of anyone or any group who may participate in the annual Barnesville Buggy Days parade. In consideration for participation in the Buggy Days Parade, the individual or group does hereby release and forever discharge the City of Barnesville, the Barnesville-Lamar County Chamber of Commerce, including its members and Board of Directors, of any claims and/or demands for loss, damage or injury while participating in the Buggy Days Parade.

Since the purpose of the parade is for entertainment, the parade committee recommends all riders be well-dressed. Period costumes are encouraged. Horses should be clean and well-groomed.

1st, 2nd, 3rd place prizes will be given for creativity and dressing according to the Buggy Days Theme:

“Original and Genuine”

Volunteers will be in the staging area to direct riders to watering areas.

Riders and carriage owners should check all equipment before parade day.

Under Georgia law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 12 of Title 4 of the code of Georgia annotated.
