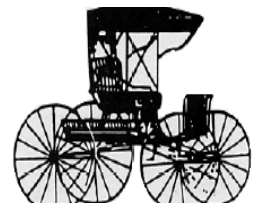

Admission

- ◆ Admission into the Miss Buggy Days Beauty Pageant is \$5.00 per person.
- ◆ Children ages 5 and under are free.

Sponsors

- ◆ You may have someone sponsor your entry fee into the Beauty Pageant. This could be family or people you or your parents do business. Sponsor fees are tax deductible as an advertising expense for a business. When contestants are introduced by the Master of Ceremonies (MC), the sponsor will be announced while the contestant is on stage. This is great advertising for local businesses.

Rules & Regulations

- ◆ Deadline for applications and fees is August 28, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. at the Chamber Office. No entries will be accepted at the door!
- ◆ **All contestants and/or parent must live, work, or attend school in Lamar County.**
- ◆ Applicants in the Miss Buggy Days division cannot be married, never been married, divorced or had a marriage annulled.
- ◆ Applicants in the Miss Buggy Days division cannot be a parent, never given birth to a child or pregnant.
- ◆ Applicants must refrain from unethical behavior during the time that she holds the *Miss Buggy Days* title.
- ◆ Each contestant 0-6 years of age may be accompanied on stage by one guardian, if necessary. Escorts should wear dark pants (no jeans or shorts) and a white top.
- ◆ Contestant entrance at the Fine Arts Center will be on the right side of the building. Only one attendant with participant allowed in the backstage area. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS.
- ◆ Due to Covid-19 and social distancing, please no make –up or hair preparation; Dressing room is for dressing only and each participant will be allowed 15 minutes to change if needed.
- ◆ **NO FOOD OR DRINKS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE AUDITORIUM or IN BACKSTAGE AREA! ONLY BOTTLED WATER!**

Awards

- ◆ A Queen and 2 finalists will be chosen in each division and will receive a trophy.
- ◆ 1st Place winners in all categories will receive a stunning crown, sash and will be invited to ride in the Buggy Days Parade on Saturday, September 19, 2020. Only category title winners will be allowed to participate in the Buggy Days Parade.
- ◆ 1st Place winners in categories from 0 months to 21 years of age will receive a \$25 cash prize. The Miss Buggy Days winner will receive a \$150 cash prize.
- ◆ One “Best Dressed” and one “Most Photogenic” will be chosen in each age division and each will receive a trophy. Photos can be black & white or color. Only one photo may be entered per contestant and these are due at the time your application is submitted. Please ensure you include your child’s name and division on the back of the photo. These will not be returned.
- ◆ Best Wishes Sponsorship Queens will receive a crown, sash, and trophy.
- ◆ There will be one, overall, People’s Choice winner, which will receive a trophy.
- ◆ **Every Contestant will receive a Participants Trophy!**

Wardrobe

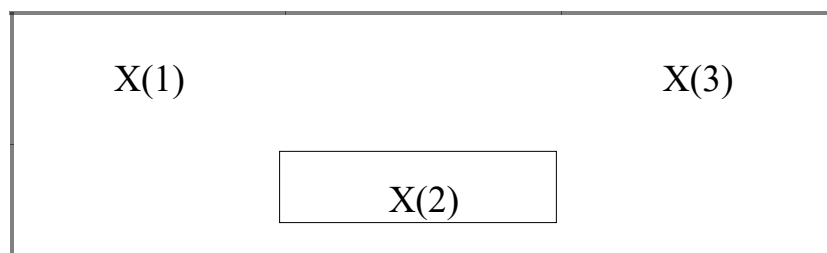
- ◆ 0-6 Years: Pageant Dress or Dressy Dress. *Tip- Lacy socks are recommended for girls under the age of 6. Light makeup preferred by judges.
- ◆ 7-12 Years: Long or Short or Pageant Dress
- ◆ 13 Years and Up: Long Prom or Pageant Dress
- ◆ 17-21 Years: Will also need Business Attire for onstage interviews in addition to long prom or pageant dress.
- ◆ Escorts: Dark pants (no jeans or shorts) and a white top.

- ◆ Selling Best Wishes Sponsorship Tickets are a fun way to pay for your entry fees and win great awards. You may win an optional award and still be eligible for your age division beauty title.

Stage Set-Up

- ◆ If you find it necessary, there will be a “Drop-In” Dress Rehearsal on Friday, September 11, 2020 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Fine Arts Center. Please practice your X’s (example of set-up found below) at home in order to be better prepared for the pageant. Due to Covid-19 only one adult is allowed to attend practice with contestant. The contestant will be allowed to walk through and practice a total of 3 times with an allotted time of 10 minutes. We ask for your cooperation to ensure everyone has a turn to practice while continuing to maintain social distancing guidelines.
