



2018 Best Projects/Individual Instructions Annual Awards

Submission Deadline: Friday, October 5th, 2018 *Submissions will be judged Tuesday, October 9th, 2018.

Awards will be presented at the 2019 AGC Annual Convention

AGC of Utah is seeking nominations for the 2018 Annual Awards program, which recognize those AGC member companies, employees and projects that have exemplified the association's motto of Skill, Integrity, and Responsibility, to be presented during our Annual Convention, Thursday January 24th, 2019.

Eligibility:

- The project must be built in Utah.
- The project must be 90% completed by the end of 2018.
- A project with a safety-related fatality, regardless of contractor or trade, is not eligible.
- There is no limit to the number of projects submitted per company and you may also submit the same project for consideration in multiple categories. However, each submittal should be tailored specifically for that category and have a separate application. Note: the committee also reserves the right to change project categories if it is to the benefit of the submitter.

Judging/Criteria:

- Winners will be selected by a panel of judges selected from the AGC membership representing Owners, General Contractors, Specialty Contractors and Service/Supplier members.
- Judges reserve the right to eliminate projects not meeting the entry requirements. As well as select no winner for a category if there are not enough submittals received.
- All entries become the property of the AGC of Utah, Submission materials will not be returned.

1. Individual/Company Awards will be reviewed and awarded based on the following criteria:

Skill – The possession and application of technical and practical skill necessary to execute the projects undertaken in a professional and efficient manner. **Integrity** – The character to comply with the spirit and letter of contracts undertaken, and to handle every transaction with fairness and honor. **Responsibility** – the possession and application of the necessary finances, cash or credit, together with the needed equipment and organization to fulfill all commitments promptly and completely.

2. Project Awards will be reviewed and awarded based on the following criteria:

- A. Project Description (**Required**-used for awards bio)
- B. Overcoming Challenges & Teamwork
- C. Safety
- D. Innovation & Contribution to the Industry/Community
- E. Construction Quality & Craftsmanship
- F. Function & Aesthetic Quality of the Design
- G. Addition Information (Optional)

Entry Requirements: (Must be sent electronically)

- **Complete Application Form** – An application form must be completed for each project submitted. If you are submitting the same project for multiple categories you must submit an additional application form for each category in which you are submitting the project.

- o **Note:** Applications are also available online at www.agc-utah.org. Once completed you can hit submit to enter in your nomination(s). You can also save and submit your application via email to mcamp@agc-utah.org.
- **Images** – Submit at least 1 image with a maximum of 5 representative of the project(s)/Individual(s). Photos should be in a high-resolution digital format such as JPEG, GIFF or TIFF. All photos should be **titled and ranked 1-5 (#1 photo will be placed on the awards plaque)** Note: before and after photos are suggested for the Renovation/Restoration category.
 - o **Note:** Once your application has been received, an email inviting you to the AGC Sharefile account will be sent to the email address provided on the application.
