<b>Highlighted Provisions:</b>	This bill: defines duties and liabilities between an operator and excavator in the damage of an underground utility facility; establishes required deadlines and procedures related to arbitration in the damage of an underground utility facility; makes changes to the membership of the Underground Facilities Damage Dispute Board; and makes technical changes. <b>Note: Operator is equally liable for damage incurred by and excavator if the excavator complies with chapter and operator fails to comply. provides a timely notice to party allegedly at fault within 45 days that the party became aware of damages; addition of board members.</b>

Licensure as a general contractor, plumbing contractor, electrical contractor - the only division-administered examination required will cover information contained in the 25hr course; additionally required will be a five-hour business law course and exam.</b>

<b>Highlighted Provisions:</b>	This bill: defines terms; prohibits an employer from seeking information regarding an applicant's employment history; gives the Labor Commission's Division of Antidiscrimination and Labor enforcement power; permits an aggrieved individual to file a request for agency action; provides for the Labor Commission to obtain representation on any appeal or to enforce any judgment of an order made under the Employment Selection Procedures Act; and makes technical and conforming changes. <b>Note: Employer can not ask or seek information regarding applicants previous employment wage or history (Gender Wage Gap issue)</b>

<b>Highlighted Provisions:</b>	This bill: incorporates statewide amendments as part of the construction code; adopts Appendix Q of the 2018 International Residential Code; adopts, statewide with amendments: the 2018 International Building Code, including Appendix J; the 2018 International Plumbing Code; the 2018 International Mechanical Code; the 2018 International Fuel Gas Code; the commercial provisions of the 2018 International Energy Conservation Code; and the 2018 International Existing Building Code; amends statewide amendments to the International Residential Code; and amends local amendments to the International Building Code for Sandy City.

<b>Highlighted Provisions:</b>	This bill: defines terms; makes it a class A misdemeanor for a person or licensed private investigator to unlawfully install a tracking device; and describes the circumstances under which a peace officer is not governed under the provisions of this bill. <b>Note: A person is not guilty of unlawful installation of a tracking device if the person installs the tracking device on a motor vehicle: with the consent of the owner or lessee of the motor vehicle.</b>
