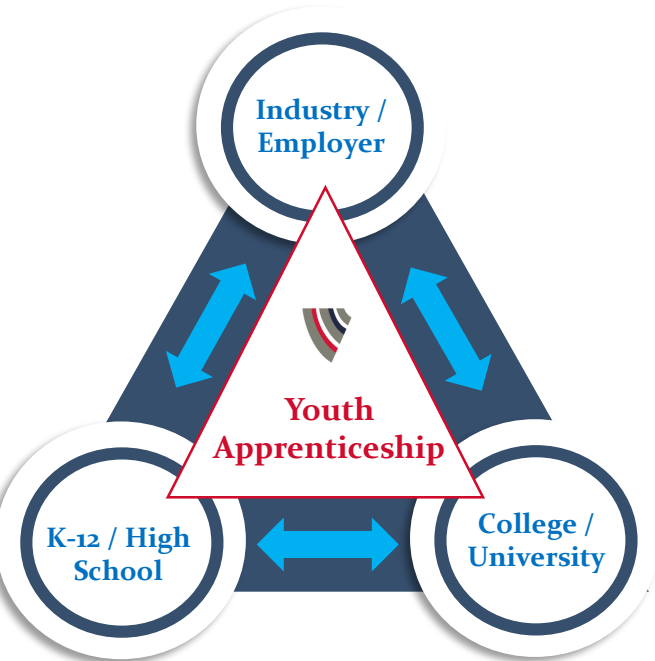

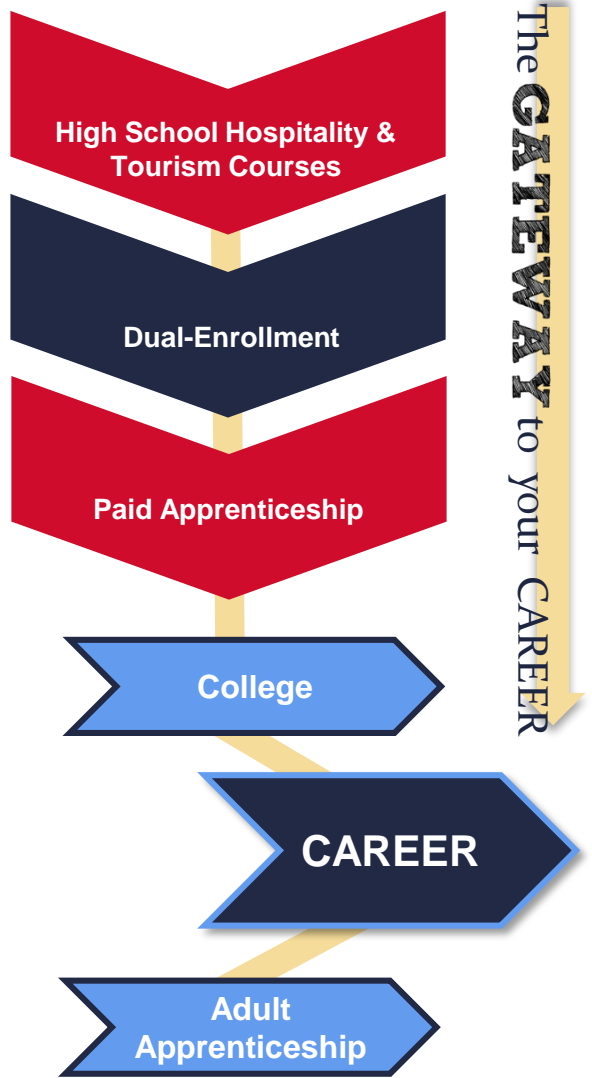

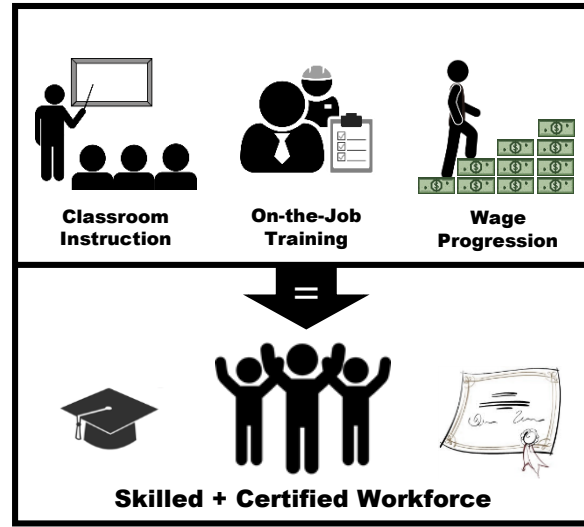




The Program
