Alysia Green joined the Asian Pacific American Chamber of Commerce (APACC) as Executive Director in June 2017. Green oversees APACC's operation, direction, strategy, innovation and more.

Previously, Green was the Regional Director of Workforce and Strategic Partnerships for New Horizons Computer Learning Centers, in Livonia, MI, where she was responsible for developing and maintaining new strategic partnerships, overseeing workforce business development strategies, providing management oversight of program development and implementation and achieving enrollment and budgetary goals for her department.
