Program Information

Requirements:

- Full attendance and active participation in the two-day, overnight stay Kick-Off Retreat Sept. 13 & 14. Retreat begins 8:00 a.m. Sept. 13 at the Ralph A. MacMullan Conference Center.
- Full attendance and active participation in **at least eight of the nine day-long sessions**. Sessions occur one day per month from September through June between 7:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- Participants are strongly encouraged, but not required, to attend the Pre-Program Orientation and Graduation.
- Active participation and an active role in the community service project.
- Graduates are expected to take on leadership responsibilities in the community.

Tuition:

The \$1,195 tuition fee includes:

- All materials
- Meals and beverages
- All costs associated with the Kick-Off Retreat, monthly sessions and Graduation

Tuition may be paid all or in part by the participant or the participant's employer and must be paid in full prior to Graduation.

Tuition assistance and payment plans may be available. To request tuition assistance and/or payment plan options, simply submit a letter along with your application explaining the circumstances surrounding your request.

Curriculum:

The intensive program examines our community's agriculture, history, education, economy, government, human needs and services, law enforcement, natural resources, arts and culture, transportation and provides leadership skills training. Participants have the unique opportunity to discuss the most critical aspects of our community with those who are personally involved.

Class Project:

Participants are challenged to exercise what they've learned as they choose and execute a Chamber class project. The time and effort required to complete the project is dependent on the project itself. Each member of the class is required to take an active role in the project.
