## Fremont Illuminated Parade Information

Friday, December 7th, beginning at 6:00 pm

(Please keep this sheet for your records)

The parade will assemble at the Fremont Fire Department and then proceed West down Main Street, to Veterans Memorial Park. All entries must be in line by 5:15 pm. judging of floats will begin at 5:30 pm. First and second place prizes will be awarded in two categories: business and organizational. Get Creative!

- Only <u>one</u> live Santa Claus, which will be provided by the Parade Committee, will be allowed to be in the parade.
- We would like you to have a minimum of 1,000 lights on all entries in the light parade. LED, Neon, and Glow products are acceptable.
- Anyone walking alongside an entry is encouraged to have a minimum of 50 lights or 15 pieces of 22" glow lights or equivalent glow shapes.
- There must be at least 1 adult for every 30 children.
- For safety reasons only lights powered by dry cell batteries may be used for individual costumes. All wires, batteries and battery packs should be concealed within the costume when possible.
- Each entry will be required to have signage in lights on the front or on both sides with the name of the entry or sponsoring group.
- We encourage all costumes be made of non-flammable material.
- Only U.L. approved wiring, lights and batteries may be used.
- The size of any costume should be constructed so that the individual wearing the costume can safely control it and can easily walk the 3 city blocks parade route. We start at the Fire station and end at Veterans Memorial Park.
- In order to keep the parade moving smoothly, entries will not be permitted to stop or perform reverse marches on the parade route. These types of activities can cause gaps in the parade.
- Proof of vehicular insurance for any motor vehicle in the parade must be made available.
- All wiring must be properly secured to prevent mechanical damage and injury to entry riders.
- Portable generators, compressors, or inverters used on the float must be securely mounted on a vehicle or other substantial base. A minimum of 12 inches must separate any part of the generator/compressor/inverter from combustible fabrication material.
- A minimum of one 2A/10BC type fire extinguisher must be provided on each float or unit.
- For safety reasons, candy, gifts, or other materials may not be thrown or handed to the crowd from any float or unit which is participating in the parade. Walkers may accompany your float in order to hand out candy, gifts, or other materials.
