2019 Fremont Harvest Festival Parade Information

Welcome to the Gerber Federal Credit Union 15th Annual Fremont Harvest Festival Parade. We are happy to have you participate in the parade and for making it a more colorful event. The theme for the 2019 Harvest Festival Parade is **"Good Ole Days"**. The following is an explanation and instructions for the parade line up. **All applications are subject to the approval of the Fremont Harvest Festival Parade Committee. Deviation from the following terms will be made at the sole discretion of the parade committee. We ask your cooperation by observing the following:**

1. **Entry applications must be in the Fremont Chamber Office no later than Wednesday, September 18, 2019.**
2. Please remove and keep this "information sheet" from the enclosed packet. **The Parade Entry Form and Application must be returned to Chamber.** This is so that the parade announcers can accurately describe your entry; please provide complete and "detailed" information. Tell us about your organization and the people involved in your entry.
3. Registration will begin at **4:00 pm** and all parade entries must register by **5:00 pm** and be in place no later than **5:15 pm**. Parade will step off at **6:00 pm** sharp. If you arrive after **5:30 pm** you will be placed at the end of the parade.
4. **The parade will stage on Hillcrest, using the Fremont Christian School, First Congregational Church, and the Fremont First Christian Reformed Church. The parade route will run from Hillcrest, turning West onto Main Street. The parade will finish at Main Street and Weaver Avenue. If you have large farm equipment and semi-trailers, please specify on your application. A parade official will contact you with parking arrangements.**
5. If you change your entry without notifying parade officials prior to application deadline, you will be placed at the end of the parade.
6. "Parade Officials" located at each parking lot staging area will be there to further instruct you to your designated line-up area.
7. In the interest of safety, parade participants are not allowed to hand out any materials from their float/entry. A violation of this rule will lead to immediate dis-qualification. Passing out candy, balloons, etc., by a walker, is welcomed if approved by the Parade Committee in advance.
8. Entries of a social issue, ones that generate emotional and ethical opinions, WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.
9. Leave 30 feet between you and the entry in front of you. Please make every effort to keep the parade moving. If you are having a problem, please pull off to the side to allow other entries to proceed.
10. **Equestrian/Horse units must provide their own clean up crew.**
11. All vehicles must be clean and in good running condition.
12. No alcoholic beverages may be consumed or displayed during the parade.
13. For those entries participating in the Antique Tractor show, you may take a right onto Weaver to pull into the Veteran's Memorial Park.

There will be a \$100 entry fee for all political entries during an election year.

Entries exempt from this fee include Chamber Members, Non-Profit Organizations, Festival Sponsors and new or antique farm equipment.
