



CYSA 2019 COMMUNITY SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP

Amount: Two \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded

Application Requirements

1. **Recommendations:** Student must have three letters of recommendation. Two must be from teachers or coaches and one must be from a personal (non-family member) reference. **10 Points**
2. **Sport Participation:** Student must have participated in at least one CYSA sport for at least one season. List each sport and year you participated with CYSA. Student will receive 5 points for each season of participation. **Maximum: 4 seasons or 20 points**
3. **GPA Requirements:** Minimum GPA of 2.5 to apply (attach transcript)
 - 2.5 to 2.99 = 5 points
 - 3.0 to 3.49 = 10 points
 - 3.5 to 3.99 = 15 points
 - 4.0 or higher = 20 points
4. **Community/Volunteer Activities:** List activities and include any letters of verification or recommendation. Points will be based on number of hours and extent of the volunteer activity. **Maximum: 20 points**
5. **Essay:** Submit essay of at least 250 words. The topic of the essay is:
"How has participation in sports benefited or influenced my life?"
Maximum: 30 points

Total Maximum Points Available: 100 points

Information

Two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each will be awarded to the most qualified applicants. The scholarships will be based on the student achieving the highest total number of points as set above. In case of a tie, the winner will be determined by a majority vote of the judges.

The scholarship will be used for the 2019-2020 academic school year. **Scholarship winners will be responsible for notifying Chugiak Youth Sports Association of the institution he/she will be attending.** Upon notification and official proof of enrollment from the institution, a check for one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) will be sent directly to that institution on behalf of the scholarship recipient. The \$1,000.00 credit will then be applied to the student's account to be used towards tuition, books, or supplies per the institution's guidelines.

The winner may use the scholarship for vocational training as well as a two or four-year accredited college.

Complete application packets must be delivered to the Chugiak Youth Sports Association office at 11925 Old Glenn Hwy, Suite 103, Eagle River, AK 99577 no later than 5:00 PM on Friday, May 25th, 2019. Awards will be announced by July 1, 2019.
