If the submitted photo(s) contain(s) clear and recognizable images of people in a privately-owned establishment, organization or residence the photographer will need to furnish a photo release form.

No payment will be provided for the entered photographs.* The photographer retains ownership and all rights to the submitted photographs subject to the following: by entering the #VisitPowellWY Photo Contest, each photographer grants PEP/ Powell Chamber/ Powell Visitor Center a nonexclusive, irrevocable license to reproduce, publish, display submitted images in any media form worldwide in promotional marketing materials for PEP, Powell Chamber, Powell Visitor Center, Powell, Park County and Wyoming.
