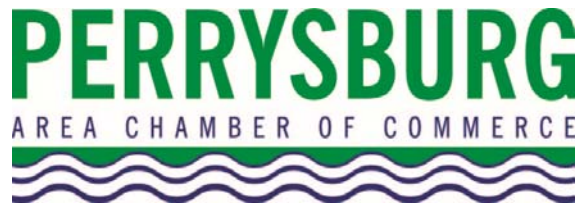

**Director of Collections at Toledo Museum of Art to Speak at
May 16th Luncheon Meeting sponsored by Creative Financial Insurance**

The May luncheon meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 16th at 11:30 a.m., at the Carranor Hunt and Polo Club, 502 East Second Street in Perrysburg. Dr. Halona Norton-Westbrook, Director of Collections at the Toledo Museum of Art, will be our guest speaker. Dr. Norton-Westbrook will speak about "Community", a special site-specific installation by artist Rebecca Louise Law that is coming to the Museum in June.

A native of California, Dr. Norton-Westbrook earned her doctorate degree at the University of Manchester, England. She became a Mellon Fellow at TMA in 2013 and served as Associate Curator of Contemporary Art and Head of Visitor Engagement. As the current Director of Collections, she is responsible for overseeing the Museum's curatorial staff, exhibitions and art conservation.

Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) help employers file and manage claims, ensure injured workers receive the quality medical care they need, and coordinate a quick and safe return to work. MCOs are an employer's first point of contact for claims, and first line of defense to control claim outcomes and premium costs.

Members of the Perrysburg Chamber are automatically considered to be members of the Northern Ohio Area Chambers of Commerce (NOACC), an organization providing business benefits to Chambers and their members. Go to www.noacc.org or call (866) 466-6222 for more information on MCO's, group health insurance, workers comp programs, and more.

BWC pays for MCO services...employers pay \$0. So pick a MCO based upon performance and service excellence.

How to select your MCO during Open Enrollment

- BWC will only permit employers to switch MCOs in May 2018. Next open enrollment is May 2020.
- Employers will choose their MCO based upon performance and service excellence - \$0 price difference.
- BWC helps employers choose their MCO based upon BWC's performance measurements. BWC will publish results in their 2018 MCO Open Enrollment Report Card. Employers can obtain a Scorecard on April 30.
- Employers switching MCOs will need to complete an Open Enrollment Form. It only takes 5 minutes.
- Employers will be barraged by marketing materials/calls during MCO Open Enrollment so be prepared.

Put your business information on display!

The Chamber office is equipped with Lucite wall displays for members to showcase their business cards. Space is also available for brochures and flyers from 3 ½" to 8 ½" wide and up to 11" tall.

If you would like to have your business information on display, just drop off some of your cards and literature to the Chamber office at 105 W. Indiana Avenue (in Perry's Landing) or bring it to any Chamber luncheon or networking event. There is a drop slot on the office door for 24/7 convenience. We suggest that you bring or send approximately 20 brochures or business cards. You are welcome to check and replenish your supply periodically. This service is free to Chamber members. Walk-in traffic at the Chamber office averages about 80 people per month looking for information to help them with upcoming relocations, new and current resident resources, business and visitor information.
