



### COMMITTEE INTEREST FORM

Membership in the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce affords the opportunity to make an impact through serving on committees. The board, staff, and our committees work together to improve the economic, civic, professional and cultural initiatives of the Pasadena Community.

#### **Standing Committees:**

- Ambassadors**- Volunteers who represent, promote and encourage participation in chamber activities and are the face of the organization in welcoming new members. They attend ribbon cuttings, ground breakings, open houses, visit members, make calls on behalf of the chamber and volunteer at various events. They meet monthly on the third Tuesday at 8:30 a.m. at the chamber.
- Classic Club**- Fully retired men and women (ages 50+) who volunteer their time welcoming new members and awarding area businesses and residents for beautification projects. They meet monthly on the second Wednesday at 10 a.m. at the chamber.
- Community in Action**- Brings awareness to our non-profit organizations and churches in the greater Pasadena community. Their goals are to establish relationships among members and develop partnerships to better serve our community. They meet monthly on the first Thursday at 8:30 a.m. at the chamber.
- Connections Committee**- Purpose is to host events that educate, inspire and connect members together. This committee oversees the planning and implementation of the membership breakfasts and luncheons.
- Government Relations Committee**- Purpose is to be a strong, well-informed advocate for the business community in monitoring and influencing policy at the local, state and national level. The chamber will advocate for policies and legislation that contribute to the growth, prosperity, and sustainability of our city and region. They meet monthly on the second Tuesday at 3:30 p.m. at the chamber.
- Finance Committee**- Purpose is to ensure fiscally sound stewardship, establish and maintain a system of checks and balances, create awareness through financial transparency, and strategically plan for financial stability and continued success of the Pasadena Chamber.
- Membership Committee**- Purpose is to develop strategic goals for membership growth and increase overall value for members through industry-specific focus and targeted benefits. They meet monthly on the first Tuesday at 3 p.m. at the Chamber and includes a focus on both recruitment and retention efforts.

#### **Event Committees:**

The success of our fundraisers is largely due to our members who volunteer to help coordinate, facilitate and bring awareness to them. These committees meet regularly in the months leading up the event to make sponsorship calls, coordinate logistical planning, and volunteer the day of the event with various responsibilities.

- Industrial Appreciation Golf Tournament** – Purpose is to recognize industry, what it does for the community and provide scholarships to students in the industry course of studies. The event is held in May with committee meetings from January - May.
- Taste of the Town** – The largest fundraiser of the year with 30 local restaurants and a large live auction benefitting the chamber and community at large. Taste is held on the first Thursday of November annually with committee meetings from July - November.
