## From the Desk of the CEO

As I write my column each month I look back a few years to see what was going on year to date. In 2015 the Little Falls community was discussing the pros and cons of changes to the sign ordinance and labor shortages in the workforce. In 2016 the Chamber Golf Outing was subtitled “Monsoon Monday” as it rained over 6” in 24 hours and we were talking about labor shortages in the workforce. Opportunity does not always knock; sometimes you need to make it happen. Shake things up a little!

Representatives from a company that have not been members for about 10 years stopped by the Chamber last week. It is an interesting conversation as one of the men was nearing the end of his career while the other was a new hire. The “old school vs new school” approach was very evident.

Contemporary definition of old school in the business world is face-to-face contact with a potential new customer. New school is using technology to generate sales without human contact.

Ten years ago the company they represent revised their business plan eliminating chamber memberships and focused on technology to sell their product. The old school method of face-to-face interaction with potential customers is now being reinstated. Fashion is not the only thing that is cyclical! Hedge your bets and use a combination of old and new school methods expand your customer base. Chamber networking events are a place you can start that face-to-face contact.

Networking works much better if you don’t just interact with the people that you already know. Seek out people in the room that you don’t know and start the conversation. Set a goal for yourself of talking to at least 2 people that you don’t know very well and then sit down with your friends and business associates for the balance of the event.

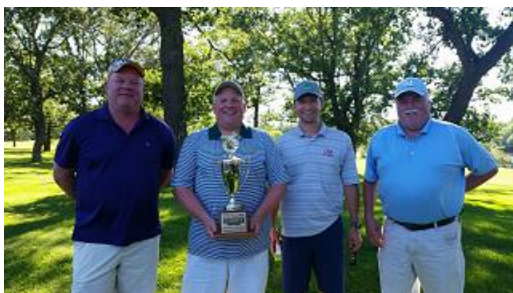
