With the strength of our Northern Community Chambers, we will foster sustainable and progressive business growth through strategic networking and partnerships.

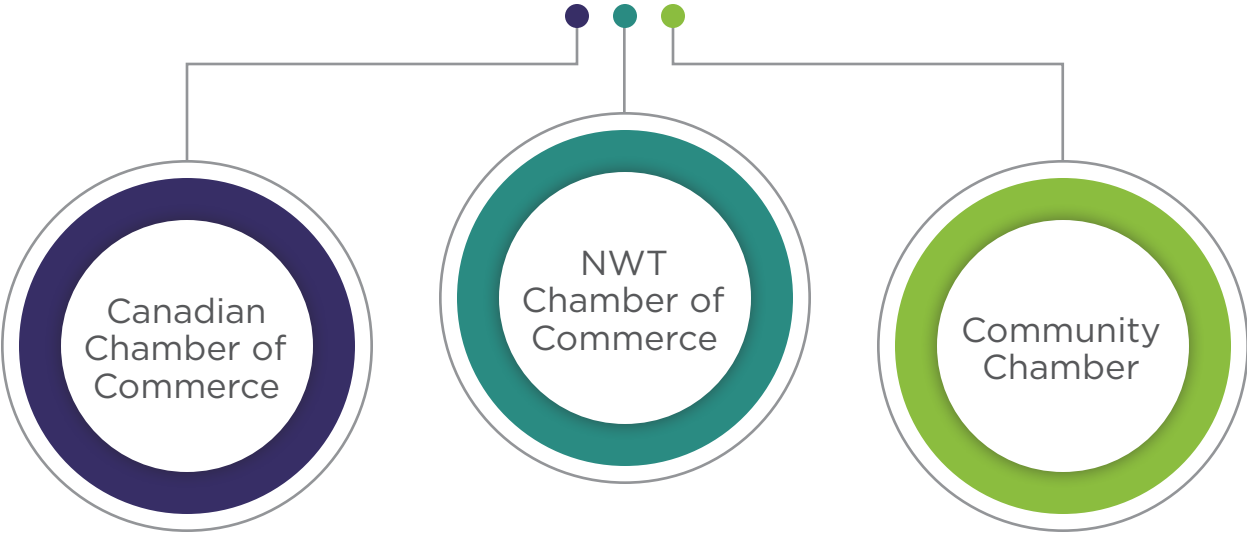
MANDATE:
