## Looking Back: Session Wrap Up

In mid-June we hosted our annual Session Wrap Up event, featuring Speaker of the House Kurt Daudt and House Minority Leader Melissa Hortman. Moderated by Tom Hauser of KSTP, both Representatives had strong opinions as to why the 2018 Legislative Session was so unproductive and disappointing. They covered many issues, from tax conformity to opioid addiction. Towards the end of the meeting, Lori Higgins noted that in a May survey to MetroNorth members, over 75% felt that legislators should return to the Capitol via a Special Session to finish their work. She then asked attending House and Senate members to respond with their opinion. Interesting, many supported the idea of a Special Session, while some felt it would be a waste of time.

Also speaking at the meeting was Tim Mafe, the Blaine High School student who received a \$500 scholarship from our Workforce

Foundation. Tim placed 2nd in the Business Professionals of America national competition this spring and has great entrepreneurial plans. We wish him much success.
