Citizen of the Year

This person epitomizes leadership. He or she will take charge when necessary and knows when to step back and give others an opportunity to shine. This person recognizes and nurtures the skills of the people around them.

Nomination Criteria:

- Active leader and advocate in business and community affairs in 2016
- Must be a current member in good standing of the Lewisville Area Chamber of Commerce
- Not a current elected official

Rookie of the Year

The Rookie of the Year Award recognizes an outstanding Lewisville Area Chamber of Commerce (LACC) member who excelled professionally in the given year and was actively involved in chamber activities and in the community. This award is presented annually at the Chamber's Annual Awards Luncheon.

If this description reminds you of a friend, colleague, or fellow business owner, nominate them for the 2015 Rookie of the Year award. Before you complete the form, please review the criteria below.

Nomination Criteria:

- A current and active member of the Lewisville Area Chamber of Commerce for a period of at least six months and no more than two years at the time of the nomination deadline.
- Previous Rookie of the Year Award winners are not eligible to win the award again.

- The selected recipient would have excelled in the following areas and will be weighted equally.
 - Committee or board participation as a member or leader
 - Community Involvement
 - Involvement with LACC events and activities as an attendee and/or volunteer

Volunteer of the Year

The Volunteer of the Year Award recognizes an outstanding Lewisville Area Chamber of Commerce (LACC) member who continually lends his/her/their time, expertise, and resources to help and improve the greater Lewisville community. This award is presented annually at the Chamber's Annual Awards Luncheon.

If this description reminds you of a friend, colleague, or fellow business owner, nominate them for the 2016 Volunteer of the Year award. Before you complete the form, please review the criteria below.

Nomination Criteria:

- Volunteer activities: Must impact the business community within the Lewisville Area Chamber.
- Time frame: Volunteer efforts upon which a nomination is based must have occurred during the eligibility year: January 1 - December 31, 2016.
- Type of service: What types of leadership role, committees, local events or programs has the nominee participated in?
- Length of service: How long has the individual, couple, family or business been actively involved? If this is the first year, what exemplified their volunteer service?
- Level of commitment: How much time and what level of personal involvement has been committed to their service?"
- Impact on community: In what way is it evident that the volunteer(s) has made lasting improvements or has effected positive change? Who has benefited and how?
- Obstacles or challenges nominee overcame: What challenges, personal or professional, or obstacles were overcome to achieve success?

Eligibility Criteria

- Nominees cannot be a current member of the Board of Directors or employee of the Lewisville Area Chamber of Commerce
- Nominees must be 18 years of age prior to January 1st of the nomination year.
- Nominee are required to be a member of the Lewisville Area Chamber of Commerce
