The planning and objectives for this program necessitate that each student must understand specific requirements before applying. Therefore, please review the requirements below before completing the application.

Requirements for participation:

- Must be a Junior or Senior in high school
- Must be on campus for at least two classes each semester
- Must be able to attend the opening session on Friday, August 24, 2018 and the Ropes Course activity on Saturday, August 25, 2018 (no exceptions); note: August 25 is an SAT testing day; you will not be excused for missing on that day to take the SAT; therefore, please plan accordingly
- Must be able to attend all other sessions (with only 2 excused absences possible)

Instructions:

This application must be completed in full (front and back). Incomplete applications will not be considered. **Students selected for the 2018-19 Junior Leadership class will be required to pay \$50 tuition to help cover expenses such as travel, meals, and supplies.** DO NOT SUBMIT MONEY WITH YOUR APPLICATION.

A student/parent orientation meeting for students selected to participate will be held in early May. Tuition and a non-refundable deadline will be explained at that time. Tuition scholarships are available.
