3/26/12: DAY 1 – CHAPEL HILL-CARRBORO/JFK/BEIJING

Travel to JFK on your own. Board an afternoon flight by 3:30 p.m. to Beijing. (Air China International Flight 982). Your adventure begins as you fly trans-Pacific aboard a wide cabin jetliner. Cross the International Dateline.

3/27/12: DAY 2 – BEIJING

(Beijing Marriot City Wall/5star, No.7 Jian Guo Men South Ave. Dong Cheng District, Tel: 0086-10-58118888) Arrive in Beijing, the Capital of China, at 6:20 p.m. Your local tour guide will meet you at the airport. Arrive at the hotel after dinner.

3/28/12: DAY 3 – BEIJING

In the morning visit the Temple of Heaven, built in 1420 A.D., where the emperors prayed to the heaven for a good harvest. Visit the 2008 Beijing Olympic venues for the outside views of National Stadium the Bird's Nest and the National Aquatic Center. Continue the tour to the Great Wall. En route visit the Jade Factory. The Great Wall, the 4,000- mile long and 2,000 years old construction is said to be the only man-made structure visible by naked eye from the moon. Visit one of the Ming tombs, one of 13 Ming Emperors' Tombs is fully excavated and open for exploration. Peking Roast Duck dinner is arranged.

3/29/12: DAY 4 – BEIJING

Sightseeing includes the Tian An Men Square, the largest square in the world.; the Palace Museum, also known as the Forbidden City, home of 24 emperors with a total space of 9,999 rooms. Visit the Pearl Market. The Summer Palace, known for many significance such as the Long Corridor with painted gallery, Kunming Lake and Longevity Hill, Seventeen- Arch Bridge and Marble Boat. Optional tour: Hutong Tour: \$35/pp

3/30/12: DAY 5 – BEIJING/SHANGHAI/SUZHOU

(Grand Metropark Hotel Suzhou/5star, 1355 Jinjihu Avenue, Suzhou Industrial Park, Tel: 0086-512-62800666) Take a morning Air China flight to Shanghai (CA1501) then board a tour bus to Suzhou. Afternoon sightseeing includes Tiger Hill. Optional Tour: Grand Canal Boat Ride: \$25/pp

3/31/12: DAY 6 – SUZHOU/HANGZHOU

(Crowne Plaza Hotel Hangzhou Xanadu Resort/5star, 3318 Xianghu Road, Tel:0086-571-83880888) Take a morning visit to the Suzhou Silk factory. Continue the tour with the centuries old Lingering Garden. Afternoon visit to the National Embroidery Institute to see silk embroidery, an important local craft with 1,000 years history. Take a bus riding to Hangzhou.

4/1/12: DAY 7 – HANGZHOU/SHANGHAI

(Renaissance Shanghai Putuo Hotel/5 star, No.50 Tongchuan Road, Putuo District, Tel: 0086-21-22195888) In the morning have a boat ride on West Lake with relaxing stopover at jewel-like pagodas. Visit the Longjing Green Tea Plantation. The centuries old Lingyin Temple, with the main feature of the 64.3 ft-high camphor-wood carved Buddha. Continue the bus journey to Shanghai.

4/2/12: DAY 8 – SHANGHAI

The Bund, a famous waterfront park. Visit the Shanghai Silk Rug Factory. Afternoon enjoy the Yu Garden, a maze of marvelous pavilions, ponds, rocky works and over arching trees. Free time exploration of the old town bazaar. Visit the Pudong District. Optional Tour: Era Show: \$35/pp; Mag-lev Train Ride: round trip: \$25/pp

4/3/12: DAY 9 – SHANGHAI/BEIJING/JFK/CHAPEL HILL-CARRBORO

Take a morning flight to Beijing (CA1858), then an afternoon flight to JFK (Air China International Flight 981), where you will arrive at 2:20 p.m. on the same day (4/3/12). Travel from JFK on your own.
