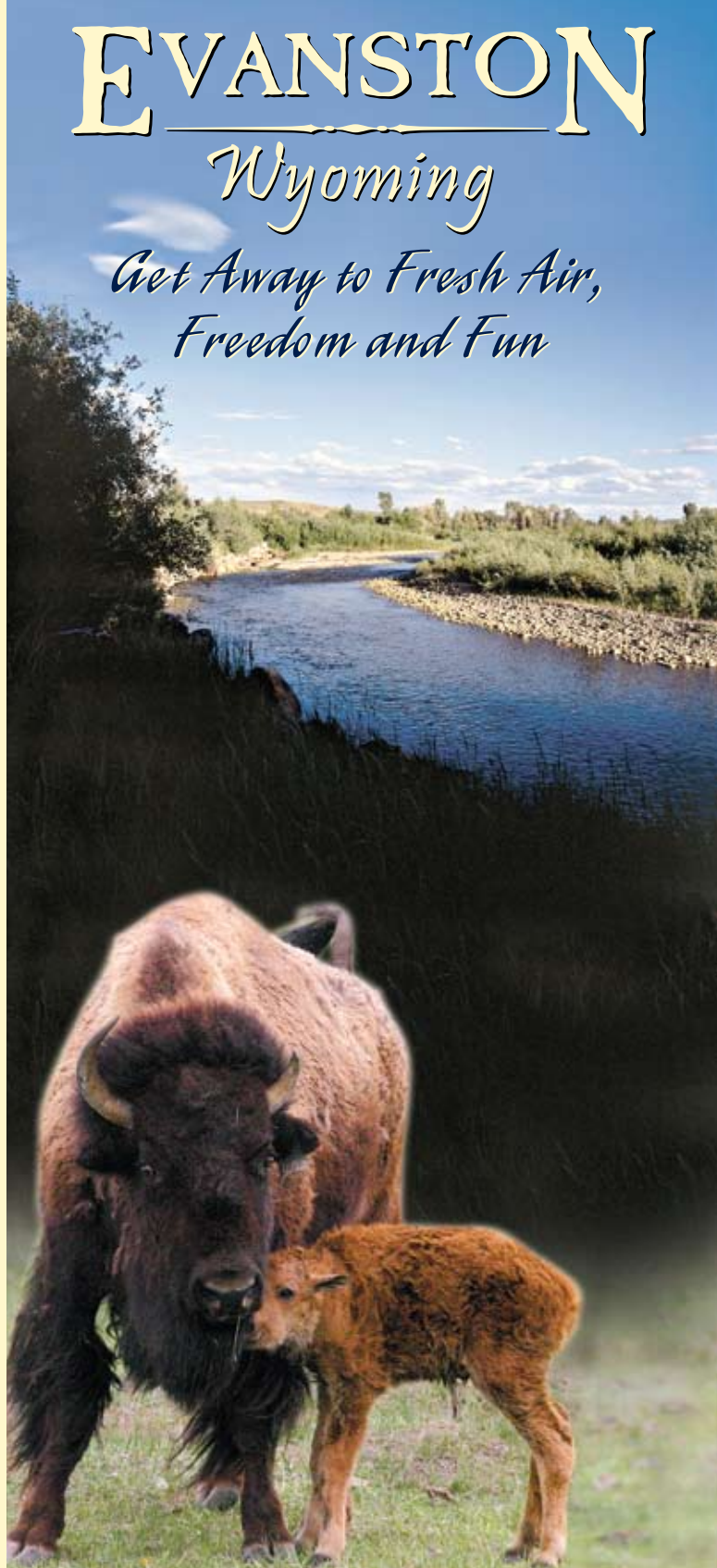

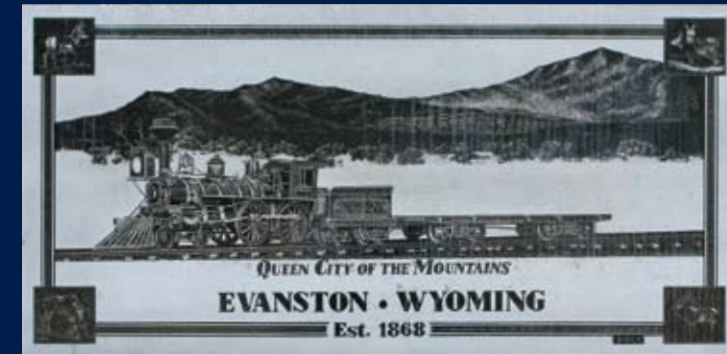

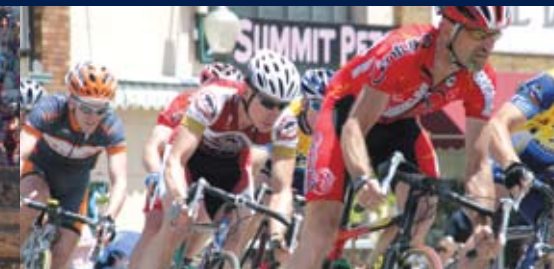


*Welcome to the city of

Nestled in the Bear River Valley, the city is framed to the south by the majestic Uinta Mountains. The Bear River flows through the community, meandering past Bear River State Park where elk and bison roam, and a community parkway where deer and people play. Our enviable quality of life is cherished by those who visit and live here.





## Area Attractions

### 1 Bear River State Park

A beautiful nature preserve within the city limits. Bear River State Park offers picnic areas, nature trails, and wildlife viewing. In the winter, enjoy cross-country skiing and a sledding hill.

### 2 Chinese Joss House Museum

Replica of the Chinese temple from Evanston's Chinatown. It contains historic artifacts from the 1870's through the 1960's.

### 2 Depot Square

Located in the heart of historic downtown Evanston. Depot Square is the setting for many of the city's local festivals. Explore the historic Union Pacific passenger depot, the Uinta County Museum in the Carnegie building, or just relax on the plaza.

### 3 Evanston River Walk

A paved walkway along the Bear River stretches 2.3 miles from 9th Street to Bear River State Park. It is a perfect place to walk, jog, bike or watch birds.

### 4 Historic Downtown Evanston

Four blocks of shopping, restaurants and galleries in the oldest buildings in town.

### Mirror Lake Scenic Byway

Wyoming Highway 150 winds through the beautiful Uinta Mountains, where you can hike, camp, fish, snowmobile and enjoy breathtaking views.

### 5 Roundhouse & Railyards Complex

Visit the last remaining complete roundhouse on the original Union Pacific Railroad line. Restoration work is ongoing - come take a look at what we've done so far!

### Sulphur Creek Reservoir

Boating, fishing, and windsurfing are favorite activities. Our February ice-fishing derby draws thousands!

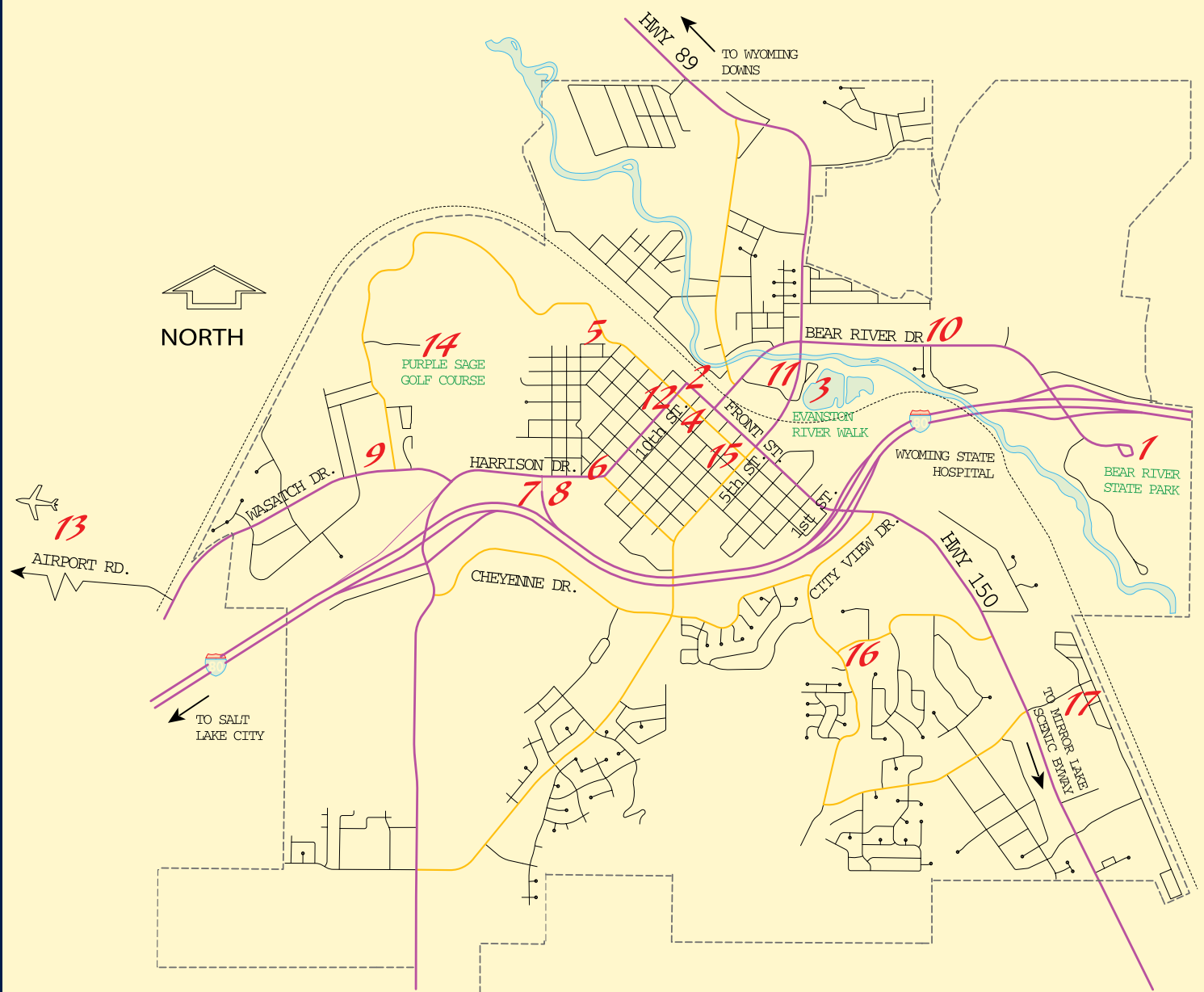

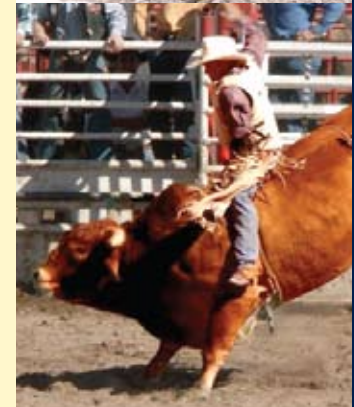

## Parks & Recreation

### **7** Bear River State Park

Exit 6 off I-80, 307-789-6547

The park is a day-use-only facility with fishing, picnic shelters, and asphalt and gravel trails for biking, hiking, and in-line skating

### Evanston Historical Walking Tour

36 10th Street, 307-783-0370

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the downtown area includes restored Depot Square, Old Carnegie Library, and a replica of the Chinese Joss House.

### Sulphur Creek Reservoir

Windsurfing, waterskiing, fishing, boating and ice fishing

## Day Trips

### Bear Lake

60 minutes north of Evanston are the turquoise-blue waters of this popular lake. It is a nice place to swim, boat or fish in the summer and snowmobile in the winter.

### Bear River Lodge

30 minutes south of Evanston, 800-559-1121. ATV riding, snowmobiling, cross country skiing, fishing and cabins.

### Flaming Gorge

90 minutes east of Evanston on I-80 is Flaming Gorge, a beautiful reservoir on the Green River. The reservoir has great fishing and the surrounding national recreation area is popular for hunting, camping and hiking.

### Fort Bridger State Historical Site

30 minutes east of Evanston is an old fort that was established in 1843 by Jim Bridger and Louis Vasquez. Those who passed through included mountain men, Indians, Mormon pioneers, the U.S. Army and the Pony Express.

### Fossil Butte National Monument

60 minutes north of Evanston, 307-877-4455. The monument protects rare plant and animal fossils from a lake that covered the area 50 million years ago. The modern visitor center, open year-round, contains many famous fish fossils.

### Piedmont Kilns

30 minutes southeast of Evanston. Piedmont kilns, built in the 1860s, provided coke for Union Pacific steam engines and charcoal for ore smelters in Utah. According to legend, Butch Cassidy buried stolen loot in this area.

### Wasatch-Cache National Forest/Mirror Lake Scenic Byway

The scenic byway is a paved highway that begins in Evanston and winds 78 miles over the Uinta Mountains to Kamas, Utah. It crosses a 10,620-foot-high pass open only in the summer. The adjacent national forest is popular for hiking, camping, snowmobiling and cross-country skiing.
