Statesville and Iredell County are in a period of transition and growth; and tomorrow's leaders need multiple tools to lead the community. They must also accept the unique opportunity and responsibility of active community involvement. This is an innovative program designed to support personal and professional leadership growth as well as to meet our community's ever growing need for the next active, knowledgeable, and dedicated leaders.

## Vibrant Coaching

We are excited to partner with Nicole Greer and Vibrant Coaching for this year's program. Nicole brings 20+ years of leadership and coaching experience that participants will have access to throughout the program. Participants will know not only what leadership is, but also understand how they can become better leaders to impact their personal lives as well as their community.



## Program Design

A diverse group of existing and potential leaders is assembled for the program to better understand themselves, their peers, their community, and more. The program includes the following key elements:

- Orientation—to review the year long experience and to set the stage for growth.
- Overnight Retreat—with a 2 day and overnight retreat, the class is able to create their own identity, build a strong bond with each other, and begin to gain a solid understanding of how to work together as growing leaders.
- Day Sessions—7 day sessions designed to explore various aspects of the community that often dive into local issues, areas of community need, and current community resources. Participants will see aspects of the community they might not have seen before as well as have the opportunity to interact with various community and business leaders.

In total, the program is a 9 month stretch to grow personally and professionally and to prepare to be a more effective leader in the community. The program concludes with a graduation reception to honor the participants and to encourage them to take the next step in their leadership journey.

One of the program's objectives and requirements is for the class to complete a community project. The process of selecting, planning, and implementing a sustainable project significantly helps grow leadership skills as well as improve our community. The Leadership Class will have to select a project together and work through the challenges and joys of implementing a sustainable project that will impact our community.

## Program Cost

The program cost is \$950 for current Chamber Members and \$1,050 for non-members. This covers all expenses of the program, including the overnight retreat, meals, speakers, refreshments, transportation and graduation.
