- A teacher with the ability to inspire students of all backgrounds and to reach their full potential.
- A teacher who exemplifies creativity, enthusiasm, commitment and development of a positive learning environment.
- A teacher who has made significant contributions in education and work with future leaders.
- A teacher who constantly goes “above and beyond”.
- Not a previous recipient of this award.
