

# Chamber Investment Schedule



## What is my investment?

The annual membership investment is based on the number of full-time (or full-time equivalent) employees, including regular employees, owners, managers, licensees, agents and commissioned sales people.

Member businesses with multiple outlets, but having the same name and under the same ownership, may enroll each outlet by combining the number of full-time equivalent employees for all outlets. Owners of multiple businesses with different names must enroll each business separately.

## Schedule One: Business Investments

Full-time staff count as one FTE each, and part-time staff as hours worked divided by full-time hours (i.e. 3 full-time employees and 4 part-time employees equals 5 FTE):

## Schedule Two: Personal (non-business) Investments

Individual membership \$143.

Individual memberships cannot be used to promote a business or service.

## Schedule Three: Non-profit Organizations and Agency Investments

Non-profit organizations and agencies \$268. To qualify, organizations or agencies must be recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as 501(c ) (3) organizations and employ 29 persons or less (full-time equivalent).
