2. There will be no buffet or salad bar; there will only be menu orders available.
3. Deli hours will be from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM daily
4. Restaurant hours will be from 5:00 PM to 10:00 PM daily
5. There will be gloves available for customers to use and hand sanitizers located at casino and hotel.

We are closely watching the CDC and South Dakota State Department of Health for any updated information on the virus.

We appreciate our customers and Employees and will do what we can to ensure a safe and clean Casino. Your continued patronage and patience is appreciated during this stressful time, and we look forward to continuing to serve you.

Hotel guests will be required to remain in their rooms during the deep cleaning times from 12 AM – 8 AM.

We have established protocols to help guests get the medical attention they may need. We are using sanitizing procedures in hotel rooms where guests who become ill are staying


