



Dear Balloon Rally Vendors,

Preparations for the **31st Annual Perry Dogwood Festival** are currently underway. The 2019 rally is scheduled for **Saturday, April 13th**. We anticipate another successful Dogwood Festival in beautiful, historic Perry, Georgia and we invite you to submit your application for the Hot Air Balloon Rally held during the event.

The Perry Dogwood Festival Hot Air Balloon Rally is a one day event beginning **Saturday afternoon** with tethered rides, vendors, live music, and kids zone opening at **5pm until 9pm**. This event takes place at the Georgia National Fairgrounds. To insure you ample time to get your booth prepared set up may begin on Saturday morning and **must be completed by 4pm**.

Over the past three years the Perry Chamber of Commerce has been implementing changes to the Hot Air Balloon Rally. The Committee's ultimate vision is a high-end, unmatched, majestic event. The Hot Air Balloon Rally acts as a large economic impact to the 31st Annual Dogwood Festival. We encourage everyone to bring blankets or lawn chairs & a picnic dinner and enjoy entertainment and the beautiful Hot Air Balloon Glow.

The Hot Air Balloon Rally is a relaxing, family friendly atmosphere. Adult tickets are only \$5 and children under 6 are free. Tethered balloon rides will be available subject to wind and weather restrictions. Tethered rides are \$10 and children under 12 years of age or under 42" must be accompanied by an adult. Children under the age of 18 must have a parent present to sign the liability waiver. The entertainment stage features live music. Unlimited play wristbands are also available by Kathy's Rock in the Kid's Zone for \$10.

The Application Deadline is March 1, 2019. Applications postmarked after this date will be assessed a \$10 late fee and will be accepted only if space is available and based on merit to the show. **No vendors will be accepted after Friday, March 30th**. Please be aware, that we are unable to guarantee space assignments from previous years. Space assignments are based particularly on the need of water/electricity and the functionality of the set up. **However, please indicate by a special note on the jury sheet, if you have any requests. We will make every effort to accommodate vendors who have worked well with us in the past.**

Unfortunately, we are not able to control the weather. As with any outdoor event, inclement weather is a possibility, so please come prepared. We will not refund any registration fees in the event of bad weather, and cannot reschedule the show. Please let us know if you have any questions. We look forward to having you join us for the 31st Annual Perry Dogwood Festival!

INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Vendor desires to use space at certain property located in Perry, Georgia (the "Property") during the Perry Chamber of Commerce Dogwood Festival on April 12 through 14, 2019;

WHEREAS, the City of Perry, Georgia ("the City") and the Perry Chamber of Commerce ("the Chamber") desire to allow the Vendor to use a portion of said space;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the issuance of the PERRY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE VENDOR APPROVAL, and the use of said space by the Vendor, and other good and valuable consideration, the Vendor does hereby represent, warrant and agree as follows:

The Vendor shall indemnify and hold harmless the City, its Mayor, City Council, Officials, employees, and agents, and the Chamber, its officers, employees and agents, from and against all claims, damages, losses, liabilities, and expenses including attorney's fees, for or on account of damage to property and/or death or bodily or other personal injury to any person or persons, arising out of or resulting from (i) Vendor's use of the City's Property and/or (ii) the acts or omissions of anyone directly or indirectly employed by Vendor or anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable.

Furthermore, the Vendor shall also indemnify and hold harmless the City, its Mayor, City Council, Officials, employees, and agents, and the Chamber, its officers, employees and agents, from and against all claims, damages, losses, liabilities, and expenses including attorney's fees arising out of or resulting from Vendor's use of the City's Property, provided that any such claim, damage, loss, liability and/or expense:

- (1) is attributable to bodily injury, sickness disease or death, or to injury or destruction of real or tangible property, including the loss of use resulting therefrom, and
- (2) is caused (i) in whole or in part by any negligent act or omission of the Vendor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by them or anyone for whose acts or omissions any of them may be liable, regardless of whether or not any such negligence is contributory in nature or (ii) by the contributory negligence of any party indemnified hereunder.

The indemnification and hold harmless terms agreed to by Vendor herein forth above shall not apply to those liabilities, claims, damages, injuries, losses or expenses arising out of bodily injury to persons, death, or damage to property caused by or resulting from the sole negligence of the City, its Mayor, City Council, Officials, employees, and agents, and the Chamber, its officers, employees and agents.

It is further agreed that if any provision of this Indemnification and Hold Harmless Agreement, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, is found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction in Houston County, Georgia, there remainder of the provisions of this Agreement, or the application of such provisions to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is found to be invalid, as the case may be, shall not be affected thereby.

I UNDERSTAND THAT THE CITY OF PERRY AND PERRY AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND ITS AGENTS ACCEPT NO LIABILITY FOR WEATHER CONDITIONS DURING THE PERRY DOGWOOD FESTIVAL IN PERRY, GA EVENT ON APRIL 12 thru 14, 2019. I ALSO UNDERSTAND THAT ONCE ACCEPTED INTO THE FESTIVAL **ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.**
