We do not sell, share or otherwise disclose the personally identifiable information you provide through this website except as follows: disclosures to third parties who perform services on our behalf, such as those who monitor the website and those who assist in preparing mailings and publish our magazine. Mailing lists are available to members of CCHR to purchase, but only the company name and address will be given. We reserve the right to use and share any information to investigate illegal conduct or violations of the Terms of Use governing this website, to comply with legal process, to assist law enforcement agencies, or if we believe in good faith it is required by law. CCHR routinely collects, compiles, and reports statistics and information reflecting the use of the CCHR website and information services in order to enhance membership services,

improve marketing and promotional efforts, analyze CCHR website usage, improve the website's content and layout, generate aggregate reports on trends, interests and behavior and enhance service offerings.
