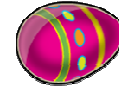




## A NIGHT IN HOLLYWOOD!!!!

## Spring Fling/German Buffet and Special Items Auction

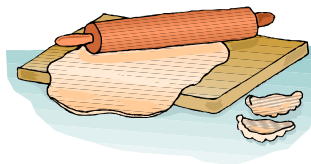


**Willkommen**

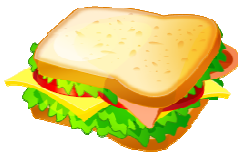

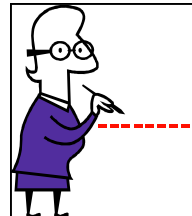

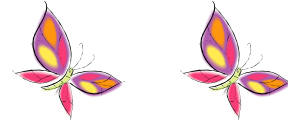
