Amalgamated Sugar's Nampa factory was built in 1942. Upon completion, Amalgamated Sugar expressed its gratitude to the community and pledged to make and keep the Treasure Valley among the most important sugar beet regions of the nation. With the enduring support of the Company's grower-owners, that pledge has been kept.

The Nampa factory has produced a total of 235,274,382 one hundred pound bags of sugar in its lifetime, creating a net revenue of \$5.88 billion that has gone back into the Treasure Valley economy. The annual payroll for the Nampa factory is over \$27 million for the approximately 500 employees at the facility.

Amalgamated Sugar has been a member of the Nampa Chamber of Commerce since the Nampa factory's construction. In 2013, Eric Erickson, Nampa Plant Manager was asked to sit on the Nampa Chamber Board, and was elected Nampa Chamber Board Chair in 2015.

As a grower-owned company, Amalgamated Sugar represents both agriculture and industry as a member of the Nampa Chamber. The Company's objective has been to communicate the role and impact our growers and factory have within the Nampa community. Amalgamated Sugar has partnered with the Nampa Chamber to promote agriculture and industries involved with agriculture throughout Canyon County. Through this partnership, the first Ag Forum was held in 2014, and the success of that event has
