**Program Purpose:**

Leadership North Port is a series of city-wide programs designed to enhance participant's awareness of our community and its needs by examining how leadership in the historical, geographical, educational, economic, governmental and cultural segments work together to perpetuate and advance the North Port community and its citizens.

The program is also designed to nurture and engage the leadership skills of potential and current leaders by providing an atmosphere that stimulates and fosters diverse viewpoints, resulting in innovative answers to the critical questions facing our community. The program strives to create awareness and to connect leaders with issues; it is not an academic leadership training program. Further, the program is not political and does not recommend or advocate policy positions on public matters.

**Program Objectives:**

- To identify and inspire future and current community leaders.
- To develop leadership skills and qualities of participants through in-depth views of the city.
- To stimulate communication among present and future leaders.
- To assist those already in leadership roles to increase their access to additional positions of community leadership in an informed and responsible manner.
- To motivate and encourage participants to assume leadership roles in community affairs.

**Program Information:**

- Application to Leadership North Port is open to persons who live or work in the North Port area.
- Leadership North Port is committed to having a diverse and dynamic membership.
- Applicants must have the full support of the company or organization by which they are employed.
- Attendance at every session is expected. Those who are absent more than two (2) class days will forfeit their membership in the class without refund of tuition. Sessions are all day (i.e. 8-5) with the exception of Arts & Culture Day, which is an evening event.

**Instructions/Selection:**

Applications must be submitted on official application form. Secure a paper form in person at the North Port Area Chamber of Commerce, on-line ([www.northportareachamber.com](http://www.northportareachamber.com)), by e-mail ([info@northportareachamber.com](mailto:info@northportareachamber.com)), or call the Chamber office at (941) 564-3040.

- Limit answers to the space provided.
- Attach one letter of recommendation.
- Applications must be fully completed (including letter of recommendation) and signed by the applicant.
- All applications are subject to a confidential review process.
- Selected applicants will receive an acceptance letter, after which tuition payment must be made by the appointed date stated in the letter.

**Selection Criteria:**

The Leadership North Port class shall be selected on the following criteria:

- Individual qualifications and not that of their employer.
- Representation from the greatest breadth of diversity in all socio-economic areas.
- Demonstrated ability to set and achieve personal and professional goals.
- Demonstrated personal commitment to the North Port community and society in general.
- A commitment to the time required by the program.
- A commitment to be a responsible and engaged participant.
- A commitment to participate in assisting with a session for the next year's Leadership North Port class.
- Applicants that are selected will be notified before September 7, 2018.

Announced candidates for public office may not "campaign" and/or use class time to promote their candidacy in any way. Submission of an application does not guarantee placement.
