



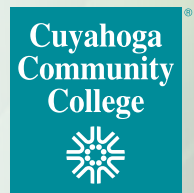
## Cuyahoga Community College offers a wide variety of educational programs of interest to Chagrin Valley Chamber of Commerce members and their families, including:

- **Degree and certificate programs** offering more than 1,000 courses in over 140 career and technical program areas.
- **Corporate College** offering Northeast Ohio businesses and individuals professional training and development, along with meeting and conferencing space.
- **Goldman Sachs 10,000 Small Businesses Program**, a program for small businesses that links learning to action. Through the program, participants will gain practical skills in topics such as negotiation, marketing, and employee management that can immediately be put into action. In addition, they will receive the tools and professional support to develop a strategic and customized growth plan to help take their business to the next level.
- **Workforce Training** providing both non-credit and credit training for individuals and businesses in career and technical program areas.
- **Non-credit Personal Enrichment Courses** spanning a broad base of career development, personal enrichment, and continuing education topics for all ages, youth through mature adult.
- **College Credit Plus**, providing eligible students in grades 7 through 12 the opportunity to earn high school and college credit that will appear on both their high school and college transcripts.
