Main Street Shakopee, Shakopee Chamber and Visitor's Bureau, and event partners invite your businesses to host a Family Fun Station during the "Open Streets – Downtown Shakopee" event on Saturday, June 4, 11am – 3pm!

Event Description: "Open Streets" is a day we close the streets to cars and open them up for people walking, biking, skating, painting, shopping, eating, and playing! More than a street festival, we're bringing the community together to explore the downtown neighborhood and local businesses. We're promoting active transportation and healthy living, giving residents and visitors an opportunity to rethink our streets as vibrant public spaces!

Family Fun Station Guidelines: The goal of hosting a station is to encourage foot traffic throughout the downtown – plan your activity booth accordingly! Open your doors, display sandwich boards, put balloons out, chalk your sidewalk, post a banner, or set-up a booth or game at your entrance! Look LIVELY! There is no fee to host a station but you must cover all costs of your station activity including supplies, rentals, hiring artists/performers, etc. Family Fun Stations are hosted at your business location downtown. If your business is not located in the event vicinity (1st Ave from Holmes St to Lewis St will be closed – stations should be within walking distance), you may host your station as a 10ftX10ft booth inside the event area (by request).
