Event Description: “Open Streets” is a day we close the streets to cars and open them up for people walking, biking, skating, painting, shopping, and playing! More than a street festival, we're bringing the community together to explore the downtown neighborhood and local businesses. We're promoting active transportation and healthy living, giving residents an opportunity to rethink our streets as public spaces. Portions of the event hubs will remain active summer-long giving Shakopee residents and visitors a chance to experience a more walkable, bikable and vibrant atmosphere!

Standard booth size is 10ftX10ft (smaller/larger sizes available). You are responsible for all activity and booth set-up (9am – 10:30am) and tear down (3:10pm). Your vehicle must be removed from the Open Streets event area.
