

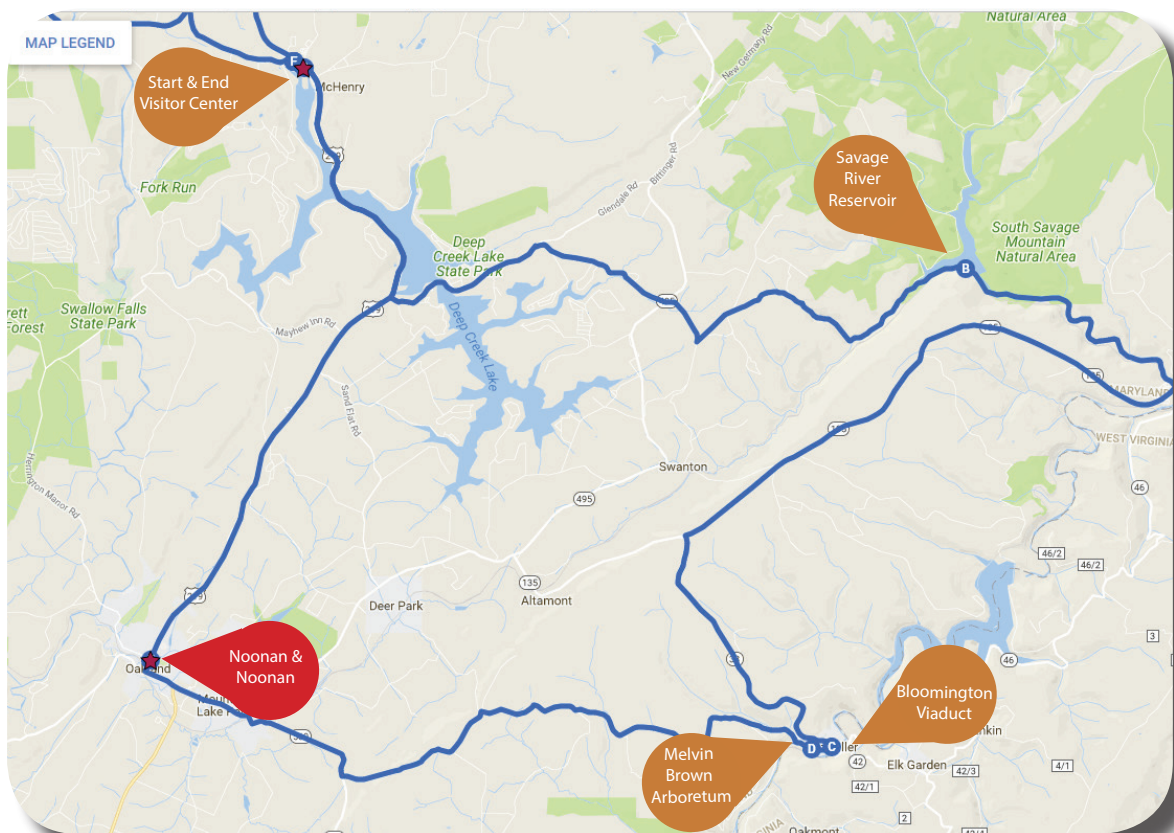
# FALL FOLIAGE DRIVING TOURS 2017

### Directions:

1. Start at the Garrett County Visitors Center at 15 Visitors Center Drive, McHenry, MD 21541
2. Turn right on Visitors Center Dr
3. Turn right onto US-219 S
4. Turn left onto Glendale Rd
5. Turn right onto N Glade Rd
6. Continue onto Mellinger Rd
7. Turn left onto Spring Lick Rd
8. Continue onto Savage River Rd
  - Explore the Savage River Reservoir: great for kayaking, fishing and wildlife viewing.
9. Head southeast on Savage River Rd

- At the end of Savage River Rd you will find yourself in the town of Bloomington. Over the North Branch of the Potomac River you will see the B&O Railroad Viaduct constructed in 1851.
10. Turn right onto MD-135 W
  11. Turn left onto MD-38 S
  12. Turn right onto W Main St
  13. 236 W Main St, Kitzmiller, MD 21538, USA
  14. Head southwest on W Main St toward 2nd St
  15. 293 W Main St, Kitzmiller, MD 21538, USA
  16. Head west on W Main St
  17. Continue onto Shallmar Rd
    - Near the school you will find the Melvin Brown Arboretum
  18. Turn right onto N Hill Rd
  19. Turn right onto Upperman Rd
  20. Turn left onto Eagle Rock Rd
  21. Continue onto Bethlehem Rd
  22. Turn right onto MD-560 N
  23. Turn right onto Paul St
  24. Continue onto Gorman St
  25. Turn left onto MD-135 W
  26. Continue onto E Oak St
  27. Turn right onto S 3rd St
    - On your right will be Noonan and Noonan, LLC.
  28. Head northeast on US-219 N/S 3rd St toward E Center St
  29. Continue to follow US-219 N
  30. Turn left onto Visitors Center Drive returning to the Garrett County Visitors Center.
