2019 River Falls St. Patrick's Day Celebration Rules and Regulations

- **Beds that are not inspected or beds that do not meet the specifications will be required to FORFEIT their place and will not be permitted to race!**
- **All team members MUST sign a waiver form prior to racing. A parent/guardian signature will be needed for any participant who is under 18 years of age.**

Inspections

1. Inspections will take place from 4-5:30 p.m. in the 100 Block of Elm St (in front of Shooter's Pub).
2. Each bed must have a bed mattress, futon mattress, or box springs. Cots and pads **do not qualify**.
3. Any type of wheels permitted, must have minimum of 3 wheels.
4. No motors, electrical, hydraulic, or mechanical assistance will be allowed.
5. All push bar extensions and dangerous edges must be **COVERED** and **PADDED** for safety.

Requirements

1. Teams for the races will consist of four (4) pushers plus one rider.
 - a. Teams are co-ed and must have two (2) pushers from each gender.
 - b. Rider can be either male or female.
2. Rider must stay on the bed at all times, except during challenges.
3. Rider must wear protective helmet while on the bed.
4. All five members of the team must be in contact with the bed **AT ALL TIMES**, except during the challenges. If at any time, any team member loses contact with the bed, the bed must come to a complete stop immediately and wait for that team member to reconnect.
5. The entire bed and all pushers must cross the finish line with challenges completed.
6. Any competitor throwing any objects at the spectators or other teams will be disqualified.

All disputes will be settled by the Chamber staff and event volunteers.
