Vendor Terms and Conditions

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General Information

- Festival date: June 16, 2018, 10am to 5pm, Rain or shine.
- Festival Location: Dorothea Jacobs Grant Common, Obed's Lane, Ogunquit
- No refunds will be issued for cancellations unless the space is re-rented. Refunds are subject to a \$25 handling fee.
- Vehicles are not allowed on festival grounds - loading and unloading must take place from Obed's Parking Lot, adjacent to the park.
- Overnight security is not provided. Overnight accommodations are not available at the site.
- Space will be assigned with goal to creating a balanced variety of products, with a limited number of spaces per category: artisans, crafters, gourmet foods, apparel. Preference will be given to local vendors of handcrafted items.
- No items using the festival name or logo may be sold without prior approval.
- Games of chance or raffles are allowed only by non-profit vendors.
- Smoking, alcoholic beverages and drugs are prohibited.
- No pets allowed.
- The festival committee reserves the right to approve or restrict any business from exhibiting and to remove anyone not complying with the rules, without issuing a refund.

Food Vendor Requirements at Event

Hand washing station
Copy of current State of Maine Health Certificate
Food items cannot be stored in direct contact with ice.
Food cannot be stored directly on the ground.
There will be no bare-handed contact with food.

Pricing

- \$100 per space for artisans and crafters selling handcrafted, first-quality items which are their own intellectual property.
- \$50 per space for local non-profit and charitable organizations.
- \$300 per space for food truck vendors.

Insurance, Permits, and Licenses

- A certificate of insurance should be provided, naming

Ogunquit Chamber of Commerce and Town of Ogunquit as additional insured during the dates of the festival.

- All vendors must have a valid Maine Sales Tax Permit obtainable through the State of Maine, Bureau of Taxation, by calling (207) 624-9693 or online at www.maine.gov/revenue. (Under Useful links, look at the 6th item on the list, and click "online".) It is the responsibility of the vendor to collect Maine sales tax. Your Maine Sales Tax ID number will be required before you will be able to set up your booth at the festival.

- Food vendors must display a copy of a current health license.

Lighting and Electrical

No electricity or lighting is available for vendors. Generators are permissible only for food truck vendors.

Truck Set-Up and Breakdown

- Vehicles will be parked in Obed's Parking Lot (gravel)
- Trucks may set up beginning at 8am.
- Trucks must be completely removed by 6:30pm.
