

## Tubing

Enjoy tubing on the beautiful Muskegon River. Tubing rates include a tube, a personal flotation device, cords to connect with other tubes in your party, and transportation to the launch site. At the end of your trip, approximately 3 hours long, you'll exit the river at Paris Park.

Call ahead to make reservations.

### Rate: \$10 per person

**Keep it Cool!** Cooler tubes and ice are available to keep your snacks and beverages refreshing.

Children under age 3 are not permitted in the watercraft; children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult. A rental agreement must be completed by a parent or legal guardian for all guest under 18 years of age.

# WELCOME to Paris Park!

Our Tubing & Transport Services include the following options:

1. **All-Inclusive Tubing Experience** – rent a tube including use of a Personal Floatation Device (PFD) and be transported up river to launch for approximately 3 hours of tubing fun on the Muskegon River, ending at Paris Park.
2. **Bring Your Own Tube, Kayak, or Canoe** – We provide transportation to the Green Township or Hersey launch sites.

**Park amenities include bathrooms, showers, picnic area's and more!**

Reservations are available Thursday - Sunday during the park operating season.



## Reservations

Reservations are required for all river trips. A variety of times are available for reservations each day, Thursday through Sunday, during the camping season (May through October) for tubing and/or transport:

10:00 a.m.	10:30 a.m.
12:00 p.m.	12:30 p.m.
2:00 p.m.	2:30 p.m.
4:00 p.m.	4:30 p.m.

Reservation times will accommodate up to 8 people each. Call the Paris Park office at **(231) 796-3420** to place your reservation.

**PAYMENT** is due upon arrival at the park.

**ARRIVAL TIME** is at least 15 minutes prior to your reservation time, to complete paperwork, pay for your reservation, park your vehicle, and be fitted with a life preserver (PFD).

## Transportation Only

Bring your own kayaks, canoes, or tubes for transportation only to two different launch sites:

- Green Township at 23 Mile Road
- Hersey at 4<sup>th</sup> Street

Call ahead to make reservations.

**Rates:**

**\$ 7 per person – Green Township**

**\$12 per person – Hersey**

## Park Entrance & Parking

Daily and seasonal park entrance permit fees are in addition to tubing and/or transport fees.

**Daily permit - \$6 per vehicle**

**Seasonal permit - \$25 per vehicle**

Permits are valid for all Mecosta County Parks:

Paris Park, Brower Park, School Section Veterans Park, Merrill-Gorrell Park, and Davis Bridge Park.

Enjoy the other amenities at Paris Park while you are here, including our campground, trout and bird feeding ponds, historic fish hatchery building, a replica of the Eiffel Tower, playground, picnic areas, boat launch, wooded trails on 40 acres, and White Pine Trail access.
