<p>PROP 1 Veteran and Affordable Housing Bond</p>	<p>A \$4 billion general obligation bond to fund affordable housing programs in California.</p>	<p>SUPPORT</p>
<p>PROP 3 Water Supply and Quality Bond</p>	<p>Authorizes a crucial \$8.877 billion bonds for California's water infrastructure.</p>	<p>SUPPORT</p>
<p>PROP 4 Children's Hospital Bond</p>	<p>\$1.5 billion to fund capital improvement programs for children's hospitals in California.</p>	<p>SUPPORT</p>
<p>PROP 6 Eliminates Road Repair Funding</p>	<p>Halts urgent safety repairs and upgrades to freeways, roads, and bridges, and makes it difficult to raise revenue for critical infrastructure in future.</p>	<p>OPPOSE</p>
<p>PROP 7 Year-Round Daylight Saving Time</p>	<p>Unnecessarily places California on year-round Daylight Saving Time, out of sync with rest of U.S.</p>	<p>OPPOSE</p>
<p>PROP 8 Limit on Dialysis Clinic Revenue</p>	<p>Reduces access for patients by capping total revenue of kidney dialysis treatment centers.</p>	<p>OPPOSE</p>
<p>PROP 10 Repeal Costa-Hawkins Protections</p>	<p>Allows unlimited rent control on single family homes and new apartments, effectively freezing new housing supply and driving up rents.</p>	<p>OPPOSE</p>
<p>PROP 11 Ambulance Employee Standards</p>	<p>Establishes common sense law so paramedics can respond to emergencies on their breaks.</p>	<p>SUPPORT</p>
<p>MEASURE B – CITY OF LA First Step to City-Run Bank</p>	<p>Voter approval is first step to risky and infeasible city-run bank.</p>	<p>OPPOSE</p>
<p>MEASURE E – CITY OF LA City Election Dates</p>	<p>Aligns City of LA elections with state elections to improve voter turnout.</p>	<p>SUPPORT</p>
<p>MEASURE EE – CITY OF LA LAUSD Election Dates</p>	<p>Aligns LAUSD elections with state elections to improve voter turnout.</p>	<p>SUPPORT</p>
<p>MEASURE W – COUNTY OF LA Tax on Rainwater</p>	<p>Penalizes lower-density Valley businesses with surface parking lots with new per-square-foot tax.</p>	<p>OPPOSE</p>
