Mandated Paid Sick Leave Would Give Businesses Only Weeks To Comply



VICA members will be aware that a proposal to increase the number of mandated paid sick days to six - double the state mandate - has been moving through the City Council. The draft ordinance has now been considered and approved by the Economic Development Committee, and is expected to go before the full City Council on Wednesday, June 1st.

The effective date of the proposed ordinance is July 1, 2016. If this ordinance is adopted by Council, businesses will have a matter of weeks to comply, including figuring out how to treat employees who work across municipalities. We urge VICA members to tell their Councilmember how this ordinance would affect your business, and urge them to oppose adoption of the ordinance, especially the unreasonably soon effective date.

VICA Board Supports Hollywood Burbank Airport Replacement Terminal



Yesterday, the VICA Board unanimously voted to support the construction of a replacement passenger terminal at the **Hollywood Burbank Airport**, which will go before Burbank voters as Measure B. The existing passenger terminal, which was built in 1930, does not meet earthquake design standards or FAA standards regarding proximity to runways and

taxiways. The airport needs a replacement terminal that has a safer distance between airport runways, meets seismic standards and improves passenger convenience. This is a great opportunity for the whole region, as the airport generates millions in tax revenues and is an economic driver for Los Angeles. Housing

The median price of a previously owned single-family home in the San Fernando Valley increased 10 percent in April from a year earlier to \$610,000, the highest level in nine years, a trade association said this week.
During the past 12 months, the median price rose \$55,000, said the Van Nuys-based Southland Regional Association of Realtors.

Job Growth

America's recovery from the Great Recession has been slow and arduous, but a new report shows that Los Angeles County is leading the way in job growth and business creation. "The New Map of Economic Growth and Recovery," from the Washington, D.C.-based Economic Innovation Group, places L.A. County at the top of the list for counties with largest number of jobs added between 2010 and 2014. The county added 352,840 jobs during that period, for a growth rate of 9.9 percent.
