



Peer Groups are small gatherings of Conway Center members that meet regularly to provide a confidential environment for family business education, idea exchange, personal and professional growth, and advice.

What are the advantages of Peer Groups?

Peer Groups give you an opportunity to learn by seeking advice from professionals and peers who have “been there, done that” and who are willing to share their knowledge and experiences – all while respecting the confidentiality of members in a small group setting. The average monthly peer group size is 10; quarterly is 20.

What Peer Groups are offered?

There are currently ten different Peer Groups – six are offered monthly; four are quarterly. Our Peer Group facilitators keep the unique needs of family businesses in mind while preparing and delivering best practice-based content. Descriptions of each Peer Group are located [here](#).

How do I participate in a Peer Group?

Peer Groups are open to all Conway Center members and their employees. Except for the CEO and Next Generation Leaders Peer Groups – all peer groups are drop-in, you just need to RSVP and show up! Can Service Providers attend Peer Groups?

Yes, except for CEO, Next Gen Leaders, and Non-Family Leaders.

Is there a fee to attend Peer Groups?

Only the CEO Peer Group has an additional fee to attend – all others are FREE as part of your Conway Center membership. This includes all family **AND** non-family employees!

Where and when are the Peer Groups held?
