**Section 150 – Traffic Control**

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*Retain section 150 as written and add the following:*

**SECTION 150.6 SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**

A. Lane Closures

1. SR 81 & all other side streets

a. Single Lane Closures

1. Single lane closures are allowed between the hours of 9:00 am to 4:00 pm and 7:00 pm to 6:00 am, Monday through Thursday.
2. Single lane closures are allowed between the hours of 9:00 am to 3:30 pm on Friday and 8:00 pm Friday to 9:00 am Saturday.
3. Single lane closures are allowed between the hours of 8:00 pm Saturday to 10:00 am Sunday.
4. Single lane closures are allowed between the hours of 8:00 pm Sunday to 6:00 am Monday.

b. Double lane closures are not allowed at any time.

2. SR 316

a. Single Lane Closures

1. Single lane closures are allowed between the hours of 9:00 am to 3:00 pm and 8:00 pm to 5:30 am, Monday through Thursday.
2. Single lane closures are allowed between the hours of 9:00 am to 3:00 pm on Friday and 8:00 pm Friday to 8:00 am Saturday.
3. Single lane closures are allowed between the hours of 9:00 pm Saturday to 9:00 am Sunday.
4. Single lane closures are allowed between the hours of 9:00 pm Sunday to 5:30 am Monday.

- b. Double lane closures are not allowed at any time.
- c. Pacing
  - 1. Pacing is allowed between the hours of 10:00 am – 2:00 pm Monday through Friday.
  - 2. Pacing is allowed between the hours of 10:00 pm – 5:00 am Monday through Sunday.
- 3. University of Georgia Home Football Games

The Contractor shall not install lane closures, pace traffic or move equipment or materials on the roadway between 3:00 pm on the Friday before the game until 9:00 am the Monday after the game throughout the Project. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to verify the schedule and plan the Work accordingly.

#### B. Milled Surfaces

The Contractor shall cover milled surfaces before they are open to traffic. Failure cover milled areas before they are open to traffic to open will result in the assessment of damages as listed in Special Provision 108.08.C.2.

#### C. Maintaining Traffic Signals

- 1. The Contractor shall maintain detection when new traffic signals are activated at all times. This may require temporary detection either by loops or video detection. Failure to maintain the detection of the traffic signals will result in assessment of non-refundable deductions as noted in Section 150.08.
- 2. The Contractor shall maintain the existing flashing beacons at all times until there is no longer a traffic signal at the at grade crossing of SR 316 and SR 81. Failure to maintain the flashing beacons will result in assessment of non-refundable deductions as noted in Section 150.08.

#### D. Detours and Staging

- 1. The Contractor may detour traffic from SR 316 EB to SR 81 for a maximum of 30 calendar days. The Contractor shall provide a notice to the Department of at least 30 calendar days in advance of the proposed detour date. All striping, guardrail, and other permeant items, including full activation of the new traffic signal, shall be completed prior to opening of the new ramp. Failure to open the new ramp from SR 316 EB to SR 81 as noted will result in the assessment of damages as listed in Special Provision 108.08.C.3.
- 2. The Contractor may detour traffic from SR 81 to SR 316 WB for a maximum of 30 calendar days. The Contractor shall provide a notice to the Department of at least 30 calendar days in advance of the proposed detour date. All striping, guardrail, and other permeant items, including full activation of the new traffic signal, shall be completed prior to opening of the new ramp. Failure to open the new ramp from SR 81 to SR 316

WB as noted will result in the assessment of damages as listed in Special Provision 108.08.C.4.

3. The Contractor shall construct the permanent tie in to Exchange Boulevard between Stations 27+00 – 28+00 in one (1) period beginning at 9:00 pm Friday until 5:00 am Monday. At a minimum, one lane of traffic must be maintained at all times. Failure to open Exchange Boulevard on at least the 19 MM Superpave pavement course, by the end of the specified time, will result in the assessment of damages as listed in Special Provision 108.08.C.5.
