Purpose of the Award

To honor licensed engineers who have made outstanding contributions to the engineering profession, the public welfare, and/or humankind.

The Awards

The names of the awards presented shall be the Engineer of the Year; Lifetime Achievement in Engineering; Engineer of the Year in Industry, Education, Government, Construction, or Private Practice; and Young Engineer of the Year. The Engineer of the Year will be selected as the highest scoring winner from the other Engineer of the Year Categories.

The Georgia Society of Professional Engineers (GSPE) coordinates the Engineer of the Year awards, which are judged by the Engineering Council of Birmingham. This acknowledgement of engineers is made possible by Georgia engineering organizations joining together to honor individuals in the Georgia engineering community.

The awardee in each category will be honored at the 2019 Georgia Engineering Awards, a black-tie event to be held on Saturday, February 23, 2019. The award will consist of an engraved plaque carrying an appropriate citation.

Eligibility for the Award

Nominees must be submitted by agencies, companies, organizations, and universities. The selection process is based on ratings received for the engineer's contributions to the profession, the public welfare, and/or humankind as listed under the purpose of the award. Each nominee must hold a professional engineering license in a U.S. state or territory and must be a resident of the State of Georgia.

Submittal Requirements

The nominations should be concise in length to assist the judging panel in their review. Please type or print clearly using the following form. **Deadline** - Please submit your nominations to Betty Jean Jordan by 5:00 p.m. on **Friday, September 21, 2018**.

5. Civic and humanitarian activities during the past five years in Georgia, including positions held

7. A minimum of three letters of endorsement from peers and fellow engineers with specific first-hand knowledge of the nominee's engineering accomplishments

8. A letter of nomination from the appropriate engineering society or engineering department head. This should be on society or company letterhead.
9. If needed, additional biographical information to describe the nominee's qualifications and accomplishments (e.g., planning, design, construction, research, education development, or management) in the category for which he/she is nominated. Please include descriptions of additional awards received in recognition of engineering accomplishments. A resume would be helpful to the judges but is not required.
10. A presentation script of 100 words or less to be read during the 2019 Georgia Engineering Awards should the nominee be selected. **PLEASE NOTE:** This presentation script may also be used in the program, *Engineering Georgia* magazine, and other media outlets should the nominee be selected.
11. Nominee's name, including designations or suffixes (P.E., Jr., etc.), and company/organization as they should appear on the award should the nominee be selected.
12. Photograph with at least 300 dpi resolution (color or black and white). **Note:** A quality photo is required for press and recognition purposes (preferably professional photo).
