TESTING SAVES LIVES!

Essential workers who interact with the public should be tested for COVID-19 regularly (once per month) to prevent the spread of the virus within our community. Examples of essential workers include:



Construction



Landscaping



Grocery/Retail



Health & Elder
Care



Childcare

In addition, anyone who is feeling sick OR had close contact with someone who has COVID-19 should be tested *immediately*.

Your Health Care Provider

Kaiser Permanente, United Health Care, health clinics, and other local medical providers now offer COVID-19 tests, even if you are not showing symptoms. Many have same-day or next-day appointments available.
