Who Should Apply?

- Washington state residents only
- Students who will be applying to any Washington state accredited community, vocational/technical college or university
- Students who can demonstrate a need for additional funding to complete their programs in a **construction industry-related field of study**

Application Packet

Submit the following five items and mail to:

1. **Application form.** Fill out completely or mark N/A if not applicable. Incomplete information may affect the rating of your application. All information you provide is strictly confidential.
2. **Three letters of recommendation** describing your qualifications that make you a clear choice for a BIAW scholarship. At least two letters should be from those who interact with you in your professional life: supervisor, co-worker, counselor, teacher, etc.
3. **Academic transcript** (unofficial copy allowed) from your last two semesters, three quarters, or a copy of your most recent transcript.
4. **Essay** (250 words min.) on your career goals.
5. **Acknowledgement** by a current BIAW local home builders association staff member in your area. See page 5 for BIAW's local home builders associations.

Application Deadline and Notification

All application packets must be **postmarked by May 4, 2018**. The selection committee will make its decision in early June. Scholarship award recipients will be contacted via mail by June 30, 2017. All applicants will be mailed notice of their final status.

Evaluation Criteria

Applicants will be judged according to the following criteria:

- 20% Academic Record
- 20% Work Experience
- 15% Community Service/Extracurricular School Activities
- 15% Recommendation
- 15% Financial Need
- 15% Essay

Distribution of Scholarships

BIAW will award:

- \$10,000 in scholarship awards to students applying to vocational/technical colleges
- An additional \$10,000 (minimum) in scholarship awards to students applying to a community college or university.
- Scholarship awards are for the 2017-2018 academic school year. Applicants may reapply for scholarship awards in subsequent years.
