## **Committees**

- **I. Advocacy** –<u>Tim Groover, Wiley Wilson</u> This committee shall provide advocacy on behalf of the engineering industry and establish rapport with pertinent governmental agencies. Members of this committee shall represent ACEC/VA on the Joint Legislative Committee (JLC), a joint committee of ACEC/VA and VSAIA. Meets as needed throughout the year.
- **II. Education** <u>Carey Andrews, Mason & Hanger</u> This committee shall provide continuing education for firm employees and promote engineering in schools of the Commonwealth. Meets 4-6 times each year.
