Please join the Life Science Caucus for a tour of the Pharmaceutical Services Network (PSN) at East Carolina University and at the Pitt County Technology Enterprise Center at Pitt Community College in Greenville, NC. The PSN trains and educates students to work in the solid oral dosage manufacturing facilities that are currently located in Eastern NC. This one-of-a-kind collaboration provides a continuum of pharmaceutical education and training to new and existing companies in North Carolina and beyond.

In addition to seeing these programs, which complement the work going on at BTEC, NC BioNetwork and BRITE that the Caucus toured previously, you will have a windshield tour of some of the pharmaceutical manufacturing facilities comprising Eastern North Carolina's growing pharmaceutical sector. Both Mayne and ThermoFisher are currently expanding their footprint in Greenville. In addition, you will have the chance to see sites targeted for additional bioscience growth at ECU.

We will begin at the ECU Heart Institute following the PhRMA "Research in Your Backyard" program (invitation attached), which features Life Science Caucus Co-Chair Representative Susan Martin (R- Wilson, Pitt). We will travel via coach to Pitt Community College and back to ECU, with the windshield tour comprising portions of the route.
