AGREEMENT FOR EXHIBITION SPACE

The **BIA-Hawaii, THE NEW SUMMER HOME BUILDING & REMODELING SHOW (HBRS)**, produced by the Building Industry Association of Hawaii (BIA-Hawaii), offers licensed contractors and suppliers the opportunity to present their services and products to consumers who are seeking information on the latest products, emerging technologies and information for residential construction under one roof.

CONTRACTOR LICENSING

Professionals who are required by law to be licensed must hold an active contractor's license on file with the Contractor's License Board (CLB) in accordance with the **Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 444 Contractors**. For licensing requirements, contact the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs Professional and Vocational Licensing Division, or the CLB at 808.586.3000.

Exhibitors providing services that require a contractor's license under state law, must provide BIA-Hawaii, an active license number with this agreement. To advertise and provide quotations for installation services, an exhibitor must advertise the license number under **Hawaii Revised Statutes 444-9.2 Advertising**. Lacking such license number, exhibitor may provide quotations only on products and not installation services.

Hawaii Revised Statutes 444-2 Exemptions – This chapter shall not apply to: (4) Any project or operation for which the aggregate contract price for labor, materials, taxes and all other items is not more than \$1,000. This exemption shall not apply in any case where a building permit is required regardless of the aggregate contract price, nor where the undertaking is only a part of a larger or major project or operation, whether undertaken by the same or a different contractor or in which a division of the project or operation is made in contracts of amounts not more than \$1,000 for the purpose of evading this chapter or otherwise.

LIABILITY INSURANCE

Exhibitors must provide a certificate of general liability insurance naming the following as additionally insured:

1. Building Industry Association of Hawaii (show promoter & certificate holder), P.O. Box 970967, Waipahu, HI 96797-0967
2. City & County of Honolulu Department of Enterprise Services and their respective members, officers, directors, agents, and employees. (site lesser), 777 Ward Ave., Honolulu, HI 96814
3. Minimum coverage of \$1,000,000 each occurrence and \$2,000,000 general aggregate.
4. Certificate of Insurance for the period of August 9-14, 2017 to be submitted to the Building Industry Association of Hawaii by Friday, July 7, 2017. Date of event to be noted on policy.

BOOTH SPACE RESERVATION AND PAYMENT

To reserve booth space, full payment must accompany this contract for exhibition space by **Friday, June 2, 2017. Space not paid in full by Friday, June 2, 2017 shall be subject to forfeiture.** The BIA-Hawaii has the right to withdraw exhibit privileges without liability of any kind on the part of its members or its sponsors. Space will be allocated as determined by BIA-Hawaii in its sole discretion. BIA-Hawaii makes no representation as to the location of your booth or its proximity to companies providing similar services or products.

All exhibitors are subject to annual approval by BIA-Hawaii. 2016 Remodel It Right Expo exhibitors have first right of refusal for newly available booth space. The BIA-Hawaii reserves the right to decline the application of any exhibitor and reserves the right to exclude, prohibit or restrict any persons, conduct, printed manner, products, displays, souvenirs, or catalogues of the exhibitor determined by BIA-Hawaii that is not in the best interest of the show and not specifically identified in this agreement.

BIA-Hawaii will review the exhibitor's application to ensure the product(s) or service(s) the exhibitor intends to sell or promote at the 2017 BIA-Hawaii, The New Summer HBRS directly relates to the show's theme residential construction and remodeling. BIA-Hawaii reserves the right to decline the application if the exhibitor does not meet this requirement.

DISPLAY AREA

Booth display areas shown on floor plan are from centerline of booth equipment, such as side rails and/or back drape. Exhibit structures must be constructed to allow sufficient tolerance on each side for this equipment and for utility service at rear of booth. Site conditions may vary. 2. 44" x 7" (approximately) booth identification sign with booth number.
3. Electricity: one 1,000 watts–110 volt electrical outlet, one per exhibitor.
4. Black Booth Carpet (9'w x 9'd) based on standard dimensions.
5. Five free name badges per booth, **subject to deadline**.

4. Labor, freight and handling.
5. Carpet, other than carpet provided by BIA-Hawaii, and removal of carpet.
6. Electrical more than the 1,000 watts provided by BIA-Hawaii.

SECURITY

Guard service will be provided at the Neal S. Blaisdell, Exhibition Hall during set-up, show days and breakdown. HOWEVER, BIA-HAWAII AND ITS SPONSORS WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE OF ANY ITEMS USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE 2017 BIA-HAWAII, THE NEW SUMMER HBRS.

EXHIBIT RULES, REGULATIONS and APPROVALS:

1. Must comply with Neal S. Blaisdell Center and City & County of Honolulu.
2. Exhibitors must promote or sell products and/or services that directly relate to residential construction and remodeling.
3. **Direct Sales (cash, invoices to be processed at a later date) are STRICTLY PROHIBITED.** This is a ZERO-TOLERANCE POLICY. Any exhibitor violating this rule will result in the exhibitor's booth to be CLOSED. All staff (owners, employees or representatives) will be immediately required to cease activities and vacate the premises. Takedown/removal of displays will be subject to MOVE OUT rules on Page 5 of this Agreement.
4. All height variances in excess of **10' and not to exceed 12'. must be requested** in writing and approved by BIA-Hawaii. Exhibitor requesting the variance will be informed of approval or denial. If height variances have not been requested or have not been granted, any exhibitor exceeding the height limitation will be requested to remove their exhibit from the show or conform to the height limitations.
5. Exhibits shall be contained within the booth area.
6. Exhibitors with (large and/or small) area rugs, must tape down corners (two sided tape is allowed) to ensure safety.
7. Displays 3 feet and lower must be AWAY from the entrance/walkway of booth.
8. All flooring must have a finished edge.
9. Interference with the light or space of other exhibitors will not be allowed.
10. Placement of signs, banners or advertising materials shall be subject to the approval of the BIA-Hawaii.
11. **Public address systems, sound/motion pictures or other demonstration with objectionable light or noise are NOT allowed.**
12. No photos will be allowed without permission of BIA-Hawaii and the exhibitor.
13. Booths shall not be altered to interfere with the flow of traffic, nor shall products or displays of service or other exhibits interfere with the flow of traffic, safety, or violate any fire or safety code.
14. Distribution of promotional items that could present a risk of bodily injury to attendees shall be subject to approval by BIA-Hawaii (i.e. yardsticks, balloons, items on sticks).
15. Exhibitors shall not serve or offer any food, soft drinks, or alcoholic beverages for compensation or gratis, for promotional, sale or any other purposes.
16. Appliance distributors or those of the like, displaying an appliance such as an oven will be allowed to bake or cook to demonstrate the product's effectiveness. Notification of such demonstration must be submitted to BIA-Hawaii 30 days prior to event.
17. BIA-Hawaii has the authority to take away any privileges should they deem it necessary. Exhibitors shall not solicit or distribute handbills, brochures or any other printed promotional material outside of their booth area, nor allow the same.
18. Exhibitors shall not display or use **helium balloons**.
19. Hand trucks or carts are not allowed during show hours. A safety regulation by Neal S. Blaisdell Center.

20. Set-up and breakdown crew must be dressed appropriately, **COVERED SHOES ARE MANDATORY**.
21. Children are **NOT** allowed during set-up and breakdown hours. A safety regulation by Neal S. Blaisdell Center and BIA-Hawaii.
22. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times during show days.
23. Contests may be held in booth area and/or at the main entrance of the show. All entry forms must have the following information printed: Company Name, Contact Name, Address, Phone number of participant, prize description, and date of drawing. Also a disclaimer that states "No Purchase Necessary" and "this information will not be used for telemarketing purposes." Exhibitors are responsible for maintaining the contents of the entry boxes during show hours.
24. Exhibitors are prohibited from dismantling exhibits or vacating booths prior to the end of the show. Failure to comply may result in loss of booth space for 2018.
25. Exhibitors shall comply with BIA-Hawaii's Code of Ethics. Basic to these ethical beliefs, we support the following objectives:
 - a. To conduct business affairs with professionalism and skill. To provide the best value possible.
 - b. To protect the consumer through the use of quality materials and construction backed by integrity and service.
 - c. To build and renovate to meet current Building Codes, with high standards of safety, sanitation and livability.
 - d. To fulfill all financial and performance obligations with regard to agreed upon time requirements.
 - e. To comply consistently with the spirit and letter of business contracts, and manage employees, sub-contractors and suppliers with fairness and honor.
 - f. To keep informed and to share knowledge regarding laws, regulations, proposed legislation, codes, public policies and other essential information which affect our business interest and those of the building industry as a whole.
 - g. To comply in both spirit and letter with the rules and regulations prescribed by law and government agencies for the health, safety and progress of the community.
 - h. To keep honesty as our guiding business policy.
 - i. To protect all parties in our business activities by putting all financial obligations and commitments in writing, expressing the exact agreement of the parties; and to provide copies of such agreements in a timely manner to all parties involved.
 - j. To provide timely and appropriate response to items covered under warranty.
 - k. To conduct business so as to avoid controversies, and should controversy arise, to seek to resolve such controversies through a non-litigation dispute resolution mechanism.
 - l. To support and abide by the decisions of the association in promoting and enforcing this Code of Ethics.

Exhibitors assume the responsibilities in this Code of Ethics freely and solemnly, feel morally and financially responsible for these obligations so assumed, and are mindful that these responsibilities are a part of their obligation as exhibitors of the 2017 BIA-Hawaii, The New Summer HBRS.

CARE OF PREMISES

1. Exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage to the building, equipment or decoration caused or occasioned by them, their employees, agents or representatives.
2. No tape, staples, glue, pins or other direct fasteners shall be used on walls, pillars, or floors of the building in such a manner as to deface or destroy same
3. Floors must be protected against substances that might produce stains, defacement, damage or dangerous conditions to both cement flooring and booth carpet.
4. Gasoline, kerosene, acetylene or other flammable or explosive substances will not be permitted in the building due to a city ordinance.
5. All televisions, lights, computer equipment or equipment requiring electricity must be turned off prior to leaving the Neal S. Blaisdell Center for the night.
6. All decorative materials must be fireproofed and must conform to the requirements of the Honolulu Fire Department.
7. Any costs incurred by BIA-Hawaii as a result of clean up or repair from damages or accidents caused by an exhibitor an exhibitor's booth will be paid by the exhibitor.

- b. All exhibitors must vacate the exhibit area by 9:00 p.m.

2. **Thursday, August 10, 2017**

- a. Exhibits set-up time 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. ***Forklift Services Available Upon Request**
- b. All exhibitors must vacate the exhibit area by 9:00 p.m.

3. **Friday, August 11, 2017**

- a. NO exhibitor move-in.
- b. NO forklift service.
- c. Any special requests must be submitted to BIA-Hawaii no later than Friday, July 7, 2017.

SHOW DAYS: August 11 – 13, 2017 – V.I.P. passes valid during show hours

1. Show Hours:

- a. Friday, August 11, 2017, from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- b. Saturday, August 12, 2017, from 9:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.
- c. Sunday, August 13, 2017, from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

2. No crating or packing of goods or uncrating or unpacking of goods will be permitted in the exhibition hall during show hours.
3. All exhibitors must vacate the exhibit area by 9:15 p.m. on Friday, August 11, 2017, 8:45 p.m. Saturday, August 12, 2017 and by 8:00 p.m. Sunday, August 13, 2017.
4. Exhibitors are prohibited from dismantling or vacating exhibit prior to the end of the show. Failure to comply may result in loss of exhibitor space for 2018.
5. No hand trucks or carts allowed during show hours, in accordance with the Neal S. Blaisdell Center rules and regulations during show hours.
6. All loads are subject to inspection by security.

MOVE OUT August 13 – 14, 2017: Breakdown Crew covered shoes MANDATORY & NO Children allowed.

1. **Sunday, August 13, 2017**

- a. Exhibits may be moved out from 4:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. ***Forklift Services Available Upon Request**
- b. Exhibition hall must be clear of attendees & aisle carpet before Exhibitor may commence breakdown.
- c. All exhibitors must vacate the exhibit area by 8:00 p.m.

2. **Monday, August 14, 2017**

- a. Exhibits may be moved out from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (noon). ***Forklift Services Available Upon Request**
- b. All exhibits must be completely dismantled and moved out by 12:00 p.m. (noon)
- c. No security guard on duty after 12:00 p.m. (noon)
- d. All loads are subject to inspection by security.
- e. Exhibitors are responsible for disposing of all crates, trash and cleaning of their area.

Do not litter aisles or obstruct traffic with exhibit items or crates during set-up or dismantling period. Exhibitors are prohibited from dismantling exhibits or vacating booths prior to the end of the show. Failure to comply may result in loss of booth space for future shows.

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FREIGHT HANDLING

Exhibitors at their own expense can arrange for receipt of shipments, delivery and reshipping after the show by prior arrangement with the 2017 BIA-Hawaii, The New Summer HBRS's, official show decorator.

EXHIBITOR NAME BADGES

1. Each exhibitor will be provided with **FIVE FREE** name badges for each booth purchased if ordered by deadline. Free name badge orders must be submitted to **BIA-Hawaii by 4:30 p.m., on Friday, July 7, 2017.** Additional name badges and ALL orders received after July 7, 2017 will be charged \$5.00 per badge. All name badges must be paid in full by Friday, July 7, 2017. Name badge orders submitted by July 7, 2017 will be available for pickup at the NBC Exhibition Hall from Wednesday, August 9, 2017.
2. Once the show opens, exhibitor entry will only be allowed with these special name badges. Any exhibitor without a name badge on the show floor will need to report directly to the BIA-Hawaii Information Booth located in the main entrance Galleria.

EXHIBITOR AGREES

1. Each exhibitor must execute a contract for the right to exhibit.
2. **SUBLETTING OR ASSIGNMENT IS PROHIBITED.** Any subletting or assignment by an exhibitor shall be null and void, and be default under this agreement in which event the BIA-Hawaii shall have the right, but not the obligation, to terminate this agreement whereupon the exhibitor shall immediately vacate the exhibit space. Subleasing includes permitting, without the prior approval of the BIA-Hawaii, any person to occupy or utilize any exhibit space for the purpose of exhibiting any product or service other than the products or services of the exhibitor who has contracted for the exhibit space, including, but not limited to, the following activities:
 - a. Company "A" executes a contract to exhibit with BIA-Hawaii, then allows Company "B" to use the exhibit space to display products or services from Company "B." A visitor to the show would then reasonably assume that Company "B" was the actual exhibitor.
 - b. Company "A" executes a contract to exhibit with BIA-Hawaii, then shares the exhibit space with Company "B." A visitor to the show would reasonably assume that both Company "A" and "B" are exhibitors.
 - c. An Industry Group executes a contract to exhibit in The New Summer HBRS, then allows its member(s) to promote products and services supplied by the individual member(s). A visitor to the show would then reasonably assume that the individual member was the actual exhibitor, rather than the industry group.
3. Each exhibitor agrees that the determination of whether an activity constitutes subletting or an assignment shall be within the sole discretion of the BIA-Hawaii; it being expressly understood that BIA-Hawaii has the absolute right to approve all exhibitors and their products and services, and any attempt to circumvent this right constitutes a default under this agreement.
4. Exhibit space agreements will not be binding in the event of fire, strike, riot, civil commotion, acts of God, war or other unavoidable circumstances which render the building unfit for use or restrict limits or prevent the presentation of the show.
5. Exhibitors shall indemnify and hold harmless the Building Industry Association of Hawaii and its sponsors from all liability, which might ensue from any, cause whatsoever.
6. The Building Industry Association of Hawaii, the BIA-Hawaii, and its sponsors shall not be responsible for damages or otherwise to any exhibitor by reason of war, civil commotion, insurrection, riot, strike, labor disputes, fire, acts of God, or any causes beyond its control which in any manner restricts, limits or cancels the show.
